Dr. James Cole received his medical degree from Midwestern University Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine. He completed his general surgery residency at William Beaumont Army Center in El Paso, Texas. Dr. Cole is board certified in general surgery and neuro-critical care. He has a special interest in trauma surgery, critical care and general surgery. He is on staff with UW Health Surgery at Swedish American Hospital.
