INFORMATION SECURITY BODY OF KNOWLEDGE

The Information Security Body of Knowledge (BOK) serves as a 'live' atlas for information security professionals who wish to build and update their knowledge. BOK 2.0 presents a high-level set of concepts, terms and activities that are of relevance to the infosec professional domains for professionals in Singapore, as defined by AiSP. As cybersecurity development and trends are fast-evolving, AiSP would incorporate regular updates together and cross-reference with cybersecurity laws and best practices overseas with its regional partners worldwide.

QISP®

The Qualified Information Security Professional (QISP®) programme is launched in 2010 to support the development of information security professionals with one to five years of working experience, through training and certification.

QISP® training is based on AiSP's Information Security Body of Knowledge (BOK). AiSP is working with training partners to develop courseware for online and classroom training in Singapore and overseas.

CREST SINGAPORE CHAPTER

The CREST Singapore Chapter was formed by CREST. The CREST Singapore Chapter was formed by CREST International in partnership with Cyber Security Agency of Singapore and AiSP to introduce CREST penetration testing certifications and accreditations to Singapore. The Singapore Chapter is the first CREST Chapter with an examination centre in Asia, and also organises the CRESTCon events to facilitate knowledge sharing in the industry.

Our ecosystem is made up of accomplished and aspiring information security professionals, students; and at the organisation level, agencies, institutes and companies.

ACADEMIC PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME

AiSP Academic Partnership Programme (APP) is open to all Institutes of Higher Learning. Besides including AiSP Student Chapter for the institutes, all full-time students, not limiting to information security or cybersecurity disciplines, will be given complimentary Affiliate membership during their course of study. AiSP would also review the IHL's course curriculum once per year.

CYBERSECURITY AWARENESS & ADVISORY PROGRAMME

The Cybersecurity Awareness and Advisory Programme (CAAP) hopes to elevate cybersecurity awareness as integral part of SME business owner's fundamentals and establish a self-sustainable support ecosystem programme with active participation from agencies, business associations, security communities and vendors.

CORPORATE PARTNER PROGRAMME

AiSP Corporate Partner Programme (CPP) offers companies a platform to be profiled as an active contributor to Singapore's cybersecurity community by:

- Supporting AiSP events and initiatives for its individual members, students and the community.
- Showcasing its knowledge and expertise to the industry as AiSP event speakers
- Committing to their personnel's continuous learning in cybersecurity and information security domains, thus, to be an employer of choice.

SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS

AiSP currently has four Special Interest Groups (SIGs) - Cloud Security, Cyber Threat Intelligence, Data and Privacy, and IoT. The SIGs:

- Engage AiSP members to advance their knowledge in this area;
- Connect with fellow volunteers through discussions, events and activities; and,
- Excel together while contributing volunteers' expertise and application to the evolving Information Security BOK and Cybersecurity Awareness and Advisory Programme (CAAP) BOK.

PARTNERSHIPS

AiSP has established MOU agreements to foster collaboration across boundaries with local and overseas partners. The aim is to collaborate on initiatives to enhance the regional cybersecurity ecosystem, through knowledge sharing, events, BOK, training and interest groups. Currently, we have 21 MOU partners where 16 are from cyber and information security associations.

LADIES IN CYBER CHARTER

The Ladies in Cyber Charter believes an important aspect of bridging the cyber talent pool gap is to build initiatives that encourage more females to enter this profession. Our current volunteer team of female cybersecurity professionals who run programmes aimed at promoting development, advancement, and inclusion of women in the cybersecurity field. We also conduct career talks and mentorship programme for the students too.

AISP VALIDATED INFORMATION SECURITY PROFESSIONAL

The AiSP Validated Information Security Professional (AVIP) membership serves the professional interests of all experienced information security professionals in Singapore, in providing a platform to validate their credentials in their professional domain. The rigour in the validation is similar to professionals in other vocations such as accountants and engineers, and it is the first in Singapore based on peer review and not criterion based.

AVIP membership is the first in Asia to bundle the Professional Indemnity for professionals involved in cybersecurity-related work, to give them greater assurance undertaking projects in Singapore and worldwide.

STUDENT VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION PROGRAMME

The Student Volunteer Recognition Programme (SVRP) aims to encourage volunteerism amongst students while developing their interest in cybersecurity. The programme will see the involvement of Institutes of Higher Learning (IHLs) in Singapore with educators encouraging students to explore their potential in cybersecurity and develop their personal and professional abilities through volunteerism. The programme is open to existing full-time students in local IHLs and there is another track for secondary school and JC students.

THE CYBERSECURITY AWARDS

The Cybersecurity Awards honour outstanding contributions by individuals and organisations, to local and regional cybersecurity ecosystems. The award categories are professionals, enterprises, NPOs and students. The Awards are organised by AiSP, supported by the Cyber Security Agency of Singapore and the professional and industry associations that are part of the Singapore Cyber Security Inter Association.

It is part of AiSP CyberFest® where a series of community-led cybersecurity events and initiatives. AiSP CyberFest® aims to nurture a more vibrant cybersecurity ecosystem for Singapore.
