5. Describing Feelings and Asking Questions	Start learning how to engage in small conversations through asking and responding to questions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Learn how to ask and respond to simple questions ▶ Learn a kīwaha/phrase suitable for the office
6. Locatives tēnei, tēnā, tērā	Learn locatives and how to start conversations in the office, including give descriptive terms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Expand on vocab ▶ Learn a kīwaha/phrase suitable for the office
7. Relationships at Home	Learn to list and describe relationships within your whānau at home. You will explore whānau relationships through a whakaaro Māori lens.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Know how to speak about your whānau in te reo Māori ▶ Learn a kīwaha/phrase suitable for the office
8. Te Reo o te Tari	This session focuses on Te reo o te Tari through a deeper lens.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ How to start conversations in the office
