

POLY LABS – ADVANCED CLAN LAB RECOGNITION WORKSHOP

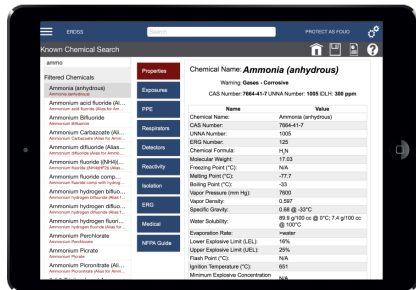
8-Hour On-Site Instructor Led Training



COURSE DESCRIPTION

The current trend across the United States is the occurrence of poly-labs, or single labs that involve multiple illicit manufacturing processes including drugs, explosives, chemical agents, and/or biological agents. This 8-hour workshop will help prepare responders and investigators to conduct an all-hazard risk-based response to a clandestine lab emergency.

Training topics will include identifying multiple lab types by the hardware, processes, and pre-cursors, and then recognizing the hazards and risks associated with the processes, regardless of threat material. Students will practice updated sampling techniques and walk-through rendering safe representative clandestine labs. Attendees will receive an updated threat briefing on the current materials of interest to domestic extremist and terrorist organizations.



EMERGENCY RESPONSE DECISION SUPPORT SOFTWARE (ERDSS)

Emergency Response Decision Support (ERDSS) software includes multiple HazMat / CBRN tools and calculators, including powerful clan lab recognition tools and is available free to first responders, military, and law enforcement personnel. If possible (but not required) attendees should bring a PC computer, ipad, or Android device to class to employ the ERDSS software in clan lab table-top scenarios.
