Guidelines, Linen Services, and Construction Information

Guidelines

1. Alcoholic beverages will not be permitted in any facility unless specific arrangements are made through the Bar Services Department and are in accordance with the Liquor Control Act of Nova Scotia. Alcohol consumption is prohibited in all public areas in residence facilities.
2. Smoking including tobacco, cannabis and vaping is prohibited on Dalhousie University campus this also includes all residence facilities.
3. Failure to disclose planned event activities could result in an inability to service your event on-site or result in additional charges (i.e., custodial or security).
4. No materials of any kind may be affixed to the ceiling or to any walls by any method whatsoever unless approved by Event & Conference Services.
5. No commercial advertising is permitted on the exterior of the facility without written permission of Event & Conference Services.
6. Dalhousie University does not permit any firearms/weapons on campus under any circumstances.
7. Guests are required to always follow the directions of Dalhousie University Security while on campus.
8. Restrictions apply on open flames in all Dalhousie University facilities. Any violation of fire regulations may result in an automatic charge to the guest's account.
9. Dalhousie University is a scent free environment.
10. Dalhousie University reserves the right to immediately evict any guest based on unacceptable behavior.
11. Guests or where guests are minors, chaperones, are responsible for all damage to, and loss of Dalhousie University property (i.e., keys, conference cards).
12. Dalhousie University is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
13. Pets are prohibited in residence facilities, except for certified service dogs (as per the Nova Scotia Service Dog Act).
14. Under no circumstances are objects to be thrown out of a residence or facility window.

Linen Exchange Service

For our guest's convenience, we offer a straightforward bed linen and towel exchange within designated linen rooms in our buildings. The linen rooms have specified open hours that are available at the front desk.

Please be aware that our exchange policy follows a 1 for 1 basis, facilitating exchanges for towels, face clothes, sheets, and pillowcases only. We are unable to offer exchanges for blankets, mattress protectors, or pillows.

Construction at Dalhousie- Summer 2024

Construction for the Dalhousie Event Centre is underway and will continue this summer. This will lead to intermittent noise disturbances around LeMarchant Place and Risley Hall. The Event Centre, slated to open in late 2025, will house an NHL-sized ice sheet with an alternate floor surface, a new state-of-the-art home for the Dalhousie Physiotherapy Clinic, and catering-equipped event spaces.
