

Voting Procedure

1. Voting Rights

- One Company One Vote: One representative from each <u>Corporate Member</u> is eligible to vote.
- Good Standing: Corporate Members who have <u>settled their membership fee</u> before the meeting are eligible to vote.

2. The Voting

- On February 27, the vote will take place as secret ballot.
- Votes will be counted by the ECCK staff under the supervision of a lawyer designated in advance during the AGM, at the end of the AGM the results will be announced.
- Election of Board of Directors
 - The candidate who receives the largest number of votes will be elected to the position.

3. Delegation of Voting Rights (PROXY)

- Members who wish to vote but <u>cannot attend</u> the meeting can <u>delegate their voting</u>
 <u>rights</u> to another Corporate Member attending the meeting.
 - (*When delegating to someone in the same company, a proxy is not required.)

Those who would like to vote through proxy may appoint a person that votes on your behalf using the Proxy Form attached.
