

1. What is the dress code?

The dress code is smart casual. We encourage everyone to be comfortable. Attendees may wear jeans and sneakers if they wish.

2. How to register before the event?

- Access the Summit page <https://app.glueup.com/event/habi-the-2022-pfip-pride-summit-59338/>
- Register using your corporate/organization email addresses
- Choose the appropriate ticket type and discount code for your company
- Complete the registration form, select preferred breakout sessions (AM and PM), and health declaration.
- After completing the registration, you will receive an email confirmation and a unique QR code that you can present on the day of check-in.

3. What time is the registration?

Please come early and the registration will start at 7:30 AM. The summit program will promptly begin at 9:00 AM

4. How to Check-in to the event?

Once you arrive at the Okada Grand Ballroom, please proceed to the registration area. Registration is according to your sponsorship tier (Partner, Platinum, Gold, Silver, Non-sponsor, and Speaker & Guest), so please line up according to the assigned lane.

Please fall in line properly and wait for your turn. Your lanyards/nametags will be given at the registration area. Delegates must download the Glue Up to have digital access to the event details.

For Onsite: you will be given a breakout session card that will indicate your chosen session, this serves as your raffle ticket too– that you can drop in the *tambyolo* after the afternoon breakout at the concierge.

For Virtual Attendees: Unique Zoom Event link will be sent to you and you need to check in and fill out your information to access the event.

5. Can we change or replace our pre-registered attendees?

Yes, but we need to be informed 2 days before the summit. Also, after July 27th we cannot assure printed name tags to all registration after this date. This will be handwritten on the day. Likewise, expect delays and waiting times.

6. What is Glue Up? Where can we download it?

Glue Up is PFIP's easy-to-use, a one-stop app for all the information you need about the Pride Summit. It contains the event program, speaker & delegates directory, FAQs, maps, personalized event schedule, and much more.

In a single app, you have complete, up-to-the-minute information and easy access to it before, during, and after an event. You won't be burdened with paper materials or wasting natural resources.

The Glue Up is available for download at the Google Play Store or the Apple App Store. Delegates are encouraged to download the app so that they can easily register for their desired break-out sessions.

7. Is it free seating?

For the plenary sessions, we have table assignments for registered delegates. Coordinate with your internal PFIP POC for your company's specific table assignment.

For the breakout session, it is based on the pre-registration and it is free seating on a first-come, first-served basis.

8. How do I choose and check in on my breakout session?

Attendees are pre-registered for AM and PM breakout sessions. Please proceed immediately to your respective sessions.

For Virtual Attendees: You can navigate the Zoom event to join your chosen breakout session. Due to the technical setup, you can only engage via the Q&A section of zoom.

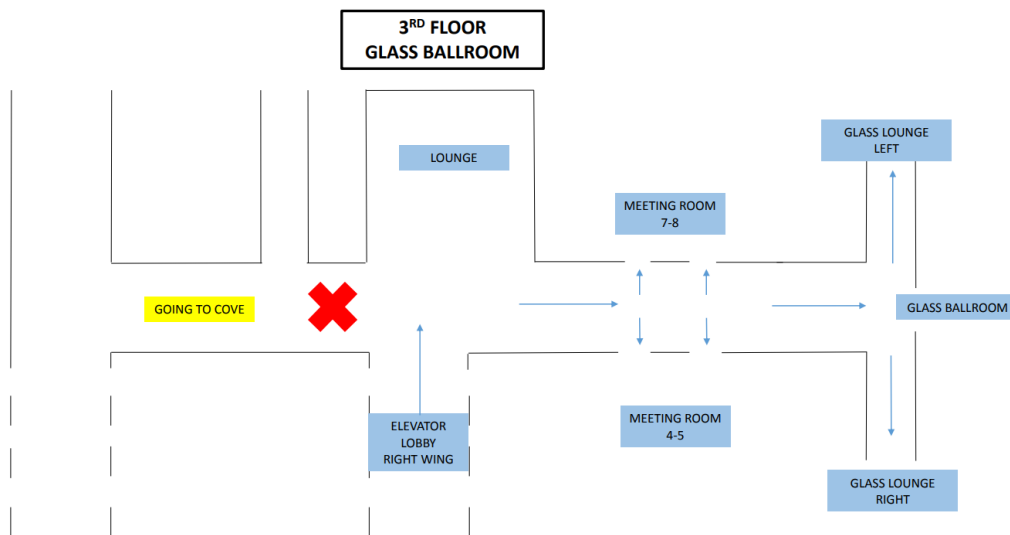
9. Where are the breakout rooms?
