

Things to know prior to attending



1. What to wear: “Dressy Casual” (Courtesy link from [Emily Post](#)):

A dressy casual dress code is a versatile balance between formal and casual. This is the ideal choice for networking (or socializing) after work, fundraisers, or dinner at a nice restaurant.

2. Arrivals from Boston Logan Airport:

Taxis or Uber/Lift are highly recommended as it is a short ride from the airport to the hotel. However, pickup for both is generally located in the terminal parking structures – a longer walk from baggage claim. Follow signs and plan accordingly.

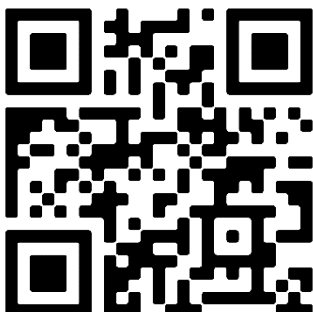
4. Dinners on your own: Saturday, Monday
