

Defining Your Role at Implementation

In order to best communicate what you do to a business owner; you must first define what your role will be in their lives. In the chart below there are several services listed. First, go through each service and determine who will perform that service for the owner – you can choose:

- Internal Partner: mark this box if you have someone within your firm that you will refer in to perform this service
- External Partner: mark this box if you have someone outside of your firm that you will refer in to perform this service

- For services you marked "You", very briefly describe this service as you provide it
- For services you marked as Internal / External Partner, identify who you have in mind. Mark N/A if you do not have anyone yet.
