Median Hourly Wage by ECE Occupation

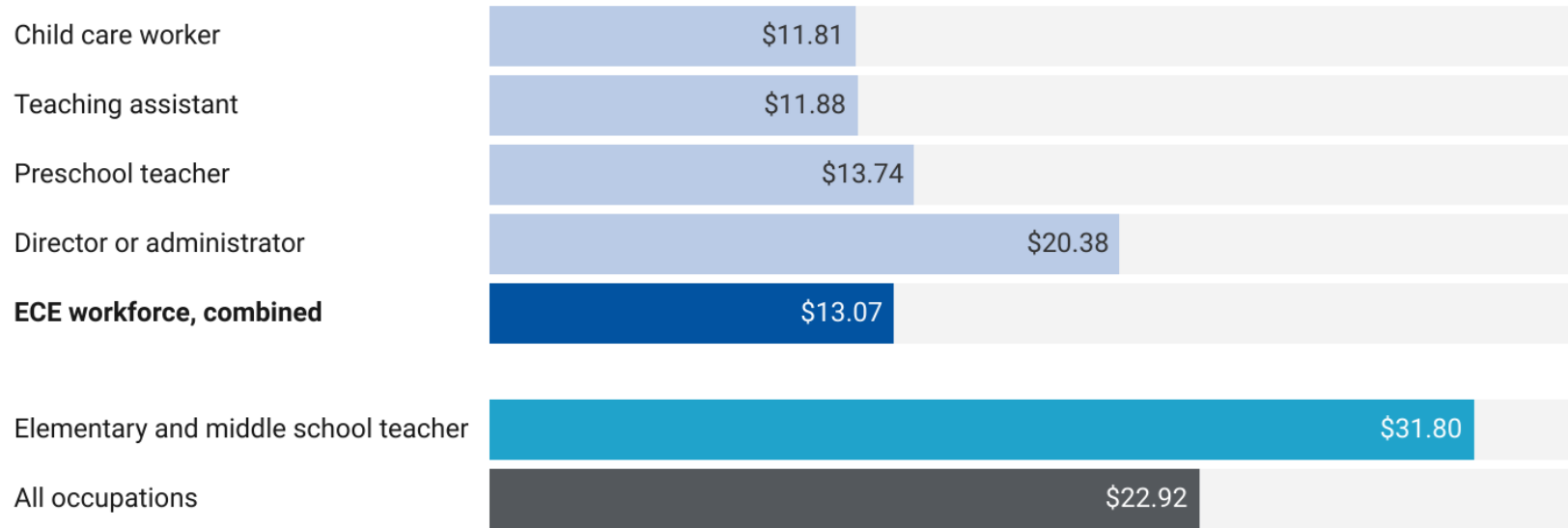
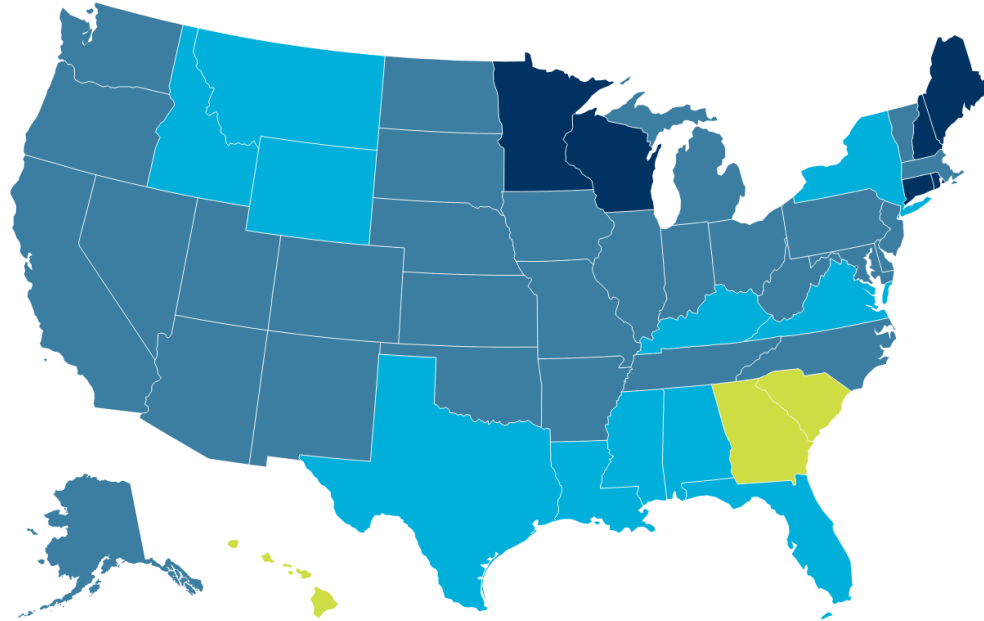

Center-based educators' perspectives on support

43%

There was enough staff to provide children with individualized attention (Teaching Supports)

36%

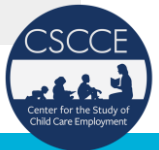
They had sufficient opportunities to meet with other teachers during paid work hours to discuss approaches to teaching (Learning Community)

32%

They had input into which classrooms children should be assigned (Job Crafting)

65%

Their program leader understood the challenges they face in their classroom (Leadership)

Educator Worry (Adult Well-Being)

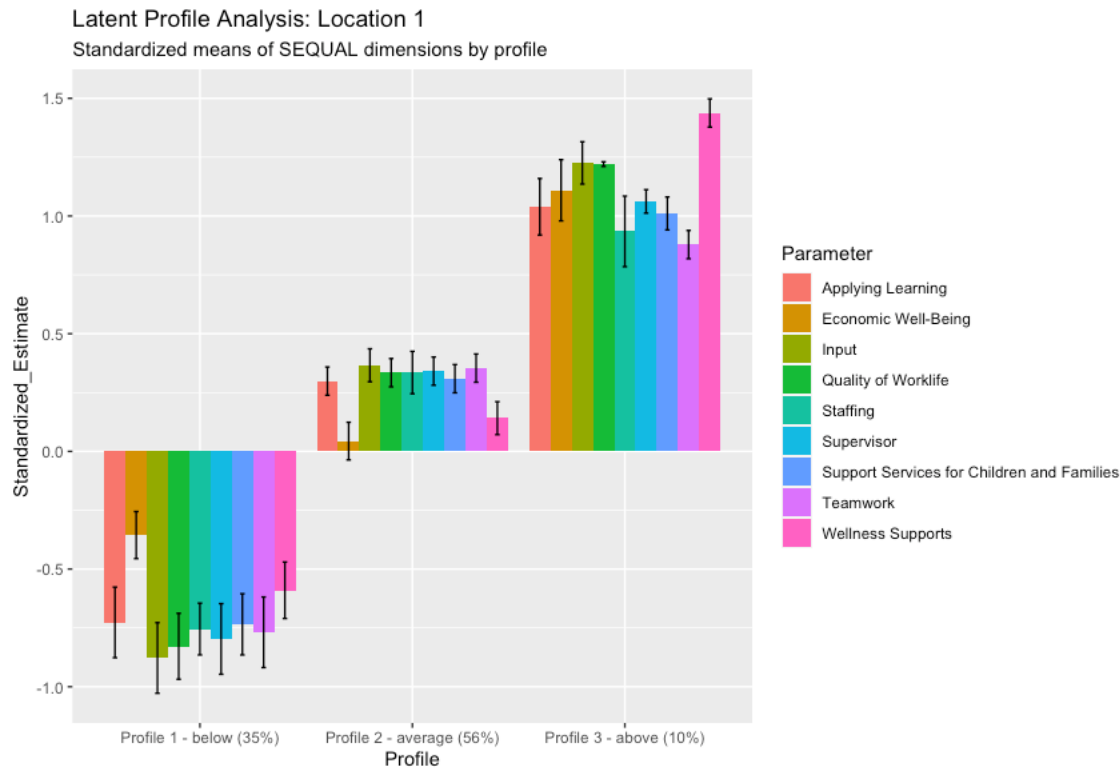

1. Educators in the **below average** profile were more likely to report they wanted to leave.
1. Educators in the **above average** profile were more likely to report they wanted to stay.
1. Some dimensions stood out: economic well-being, wellness supports in the above average profile.



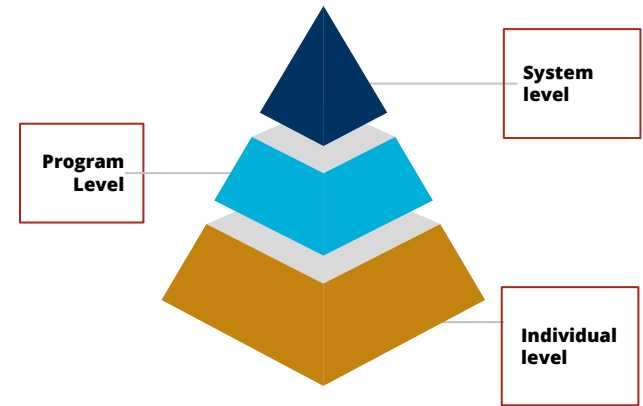
Translating into Policy and Practice

1	Comprehensive data across the whole system	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demographics & workforce characteristics, work environments• Roles; Program settings, types
2	Strategies & policies	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Standards focused on work environments• Funding towards work environment supports
3	Engaging educators & centering their experiences	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understanding educators' experiences & engaging them as experts
