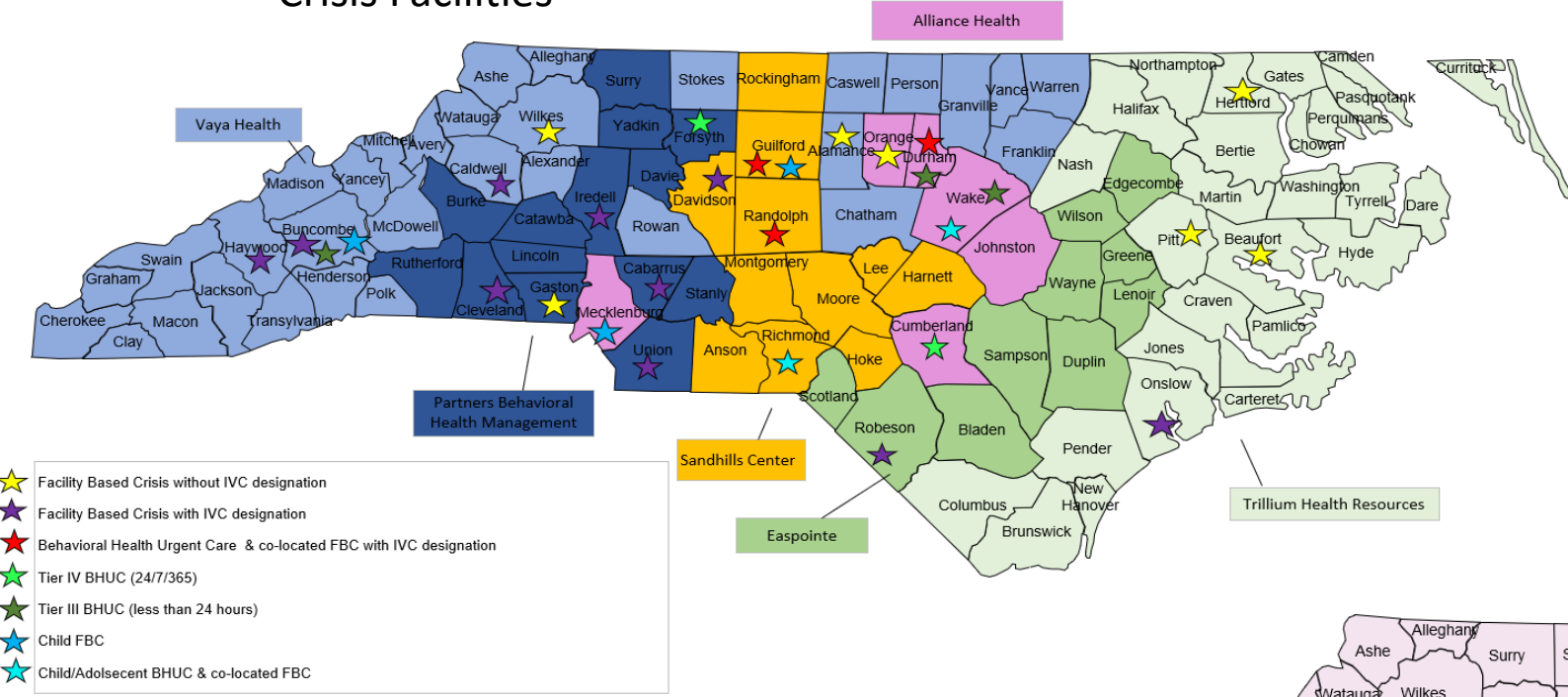

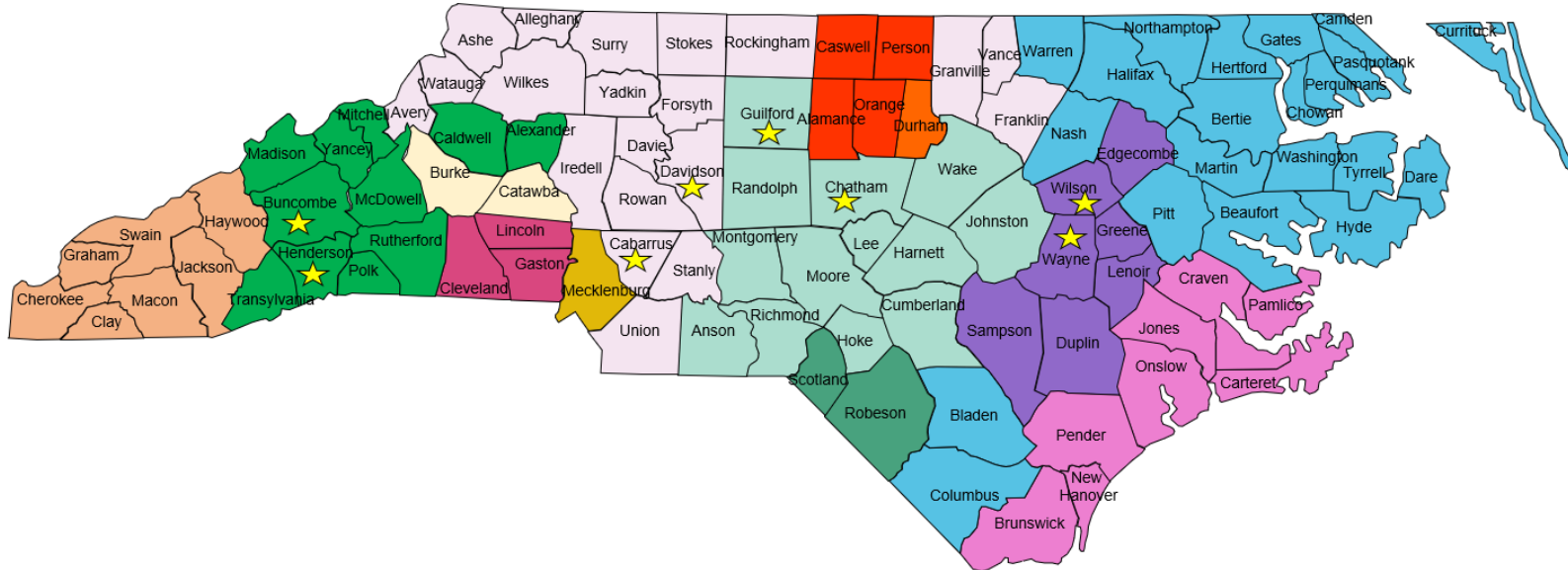

# Crisis Investments in the SFY 23-25 Budget

**\$131M** is going towards crisis across SFY23-25

<b>FY 23-25 Budget Items</b>	<b>FY23-24</b>	<b>FY24-25</b>
<b>Crisis System Improvements</b> (e.g. mobile crisis, respite)	\$30M	\$50M
<b>Non-Law Enforcement Transportation Pilot Program</b>	\$10M	\$10M
<b>Crisis Stabilization Facility Capacity</b>	\$3.2M	\$7.8M
<b>Crisis System Technology</b> (e.g., 988, bed registry)	\$10M	\$10M
<b>Totals</b>	<b>\$53.2M</b>	<b>\$77.8M</b>
