




Core Values


 Core values help navigate the gray area when law is either silent or requires subjective judgement























Prohibition Against Contracts with Officers

- A county official may not be interested in a contract made by them in their official capacity (<u>§74-501</u>)
- A county official may not purchase county goods at auction if the county official involved in the sale of the goods (§74-503)
- Contracts made in violation are voidable (§74-504), and the violating county official shall be guilty of a misdemeanor (§74-509)
- Prohibitions do not apply to to governing board members who do not receive a salary or fee (<u>§74-510</u>, <u>§18-1361A</u>)
