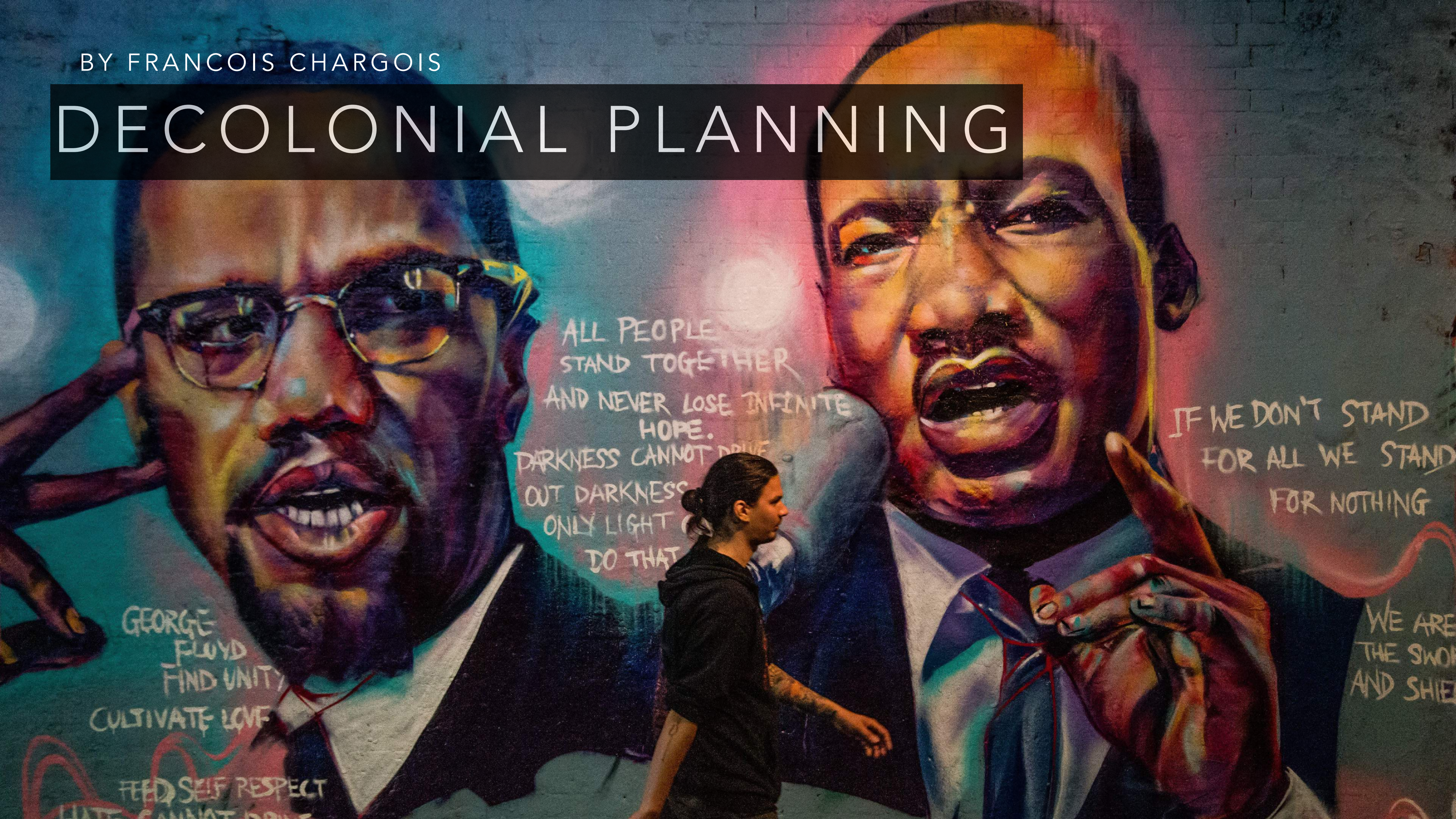

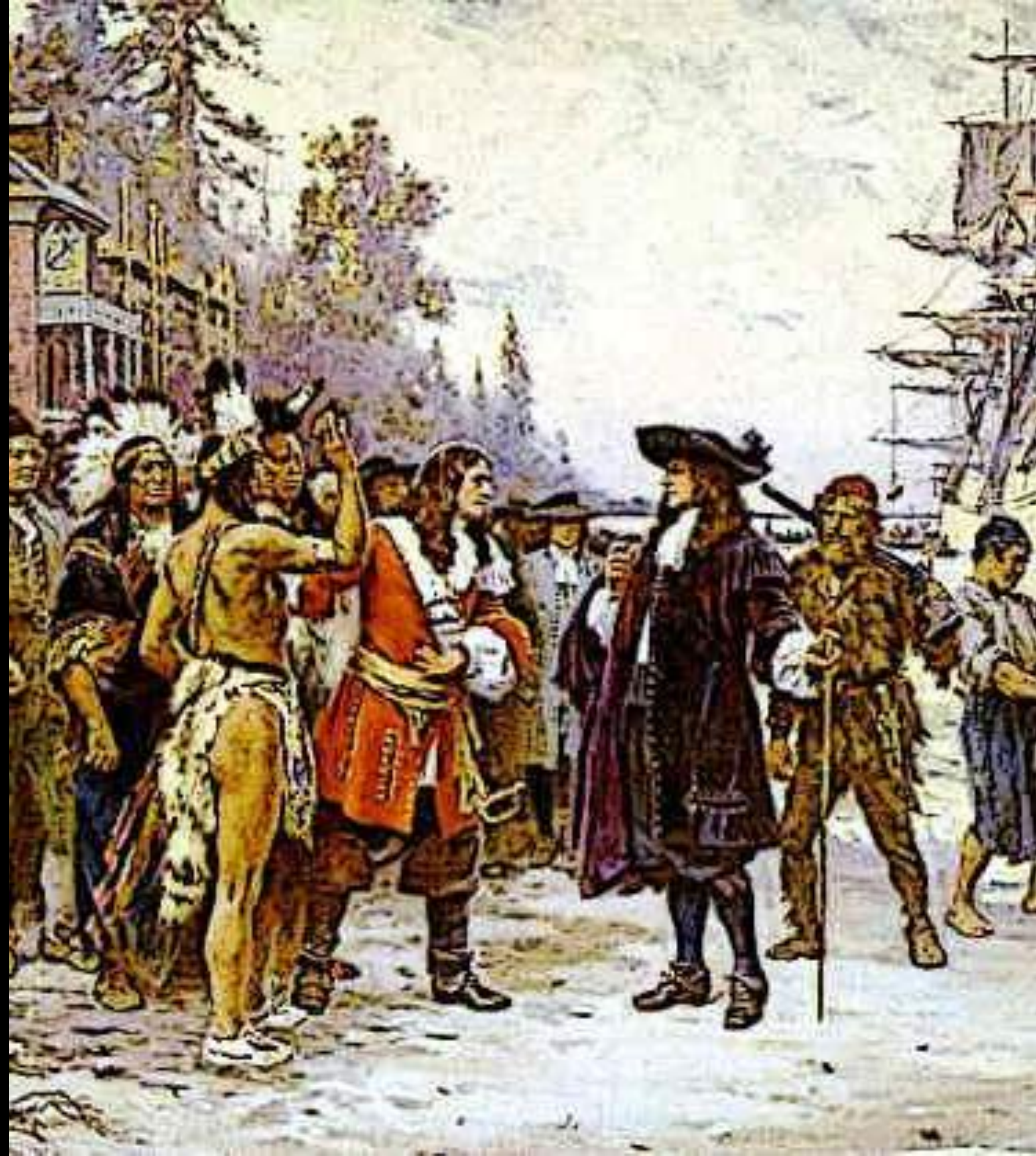

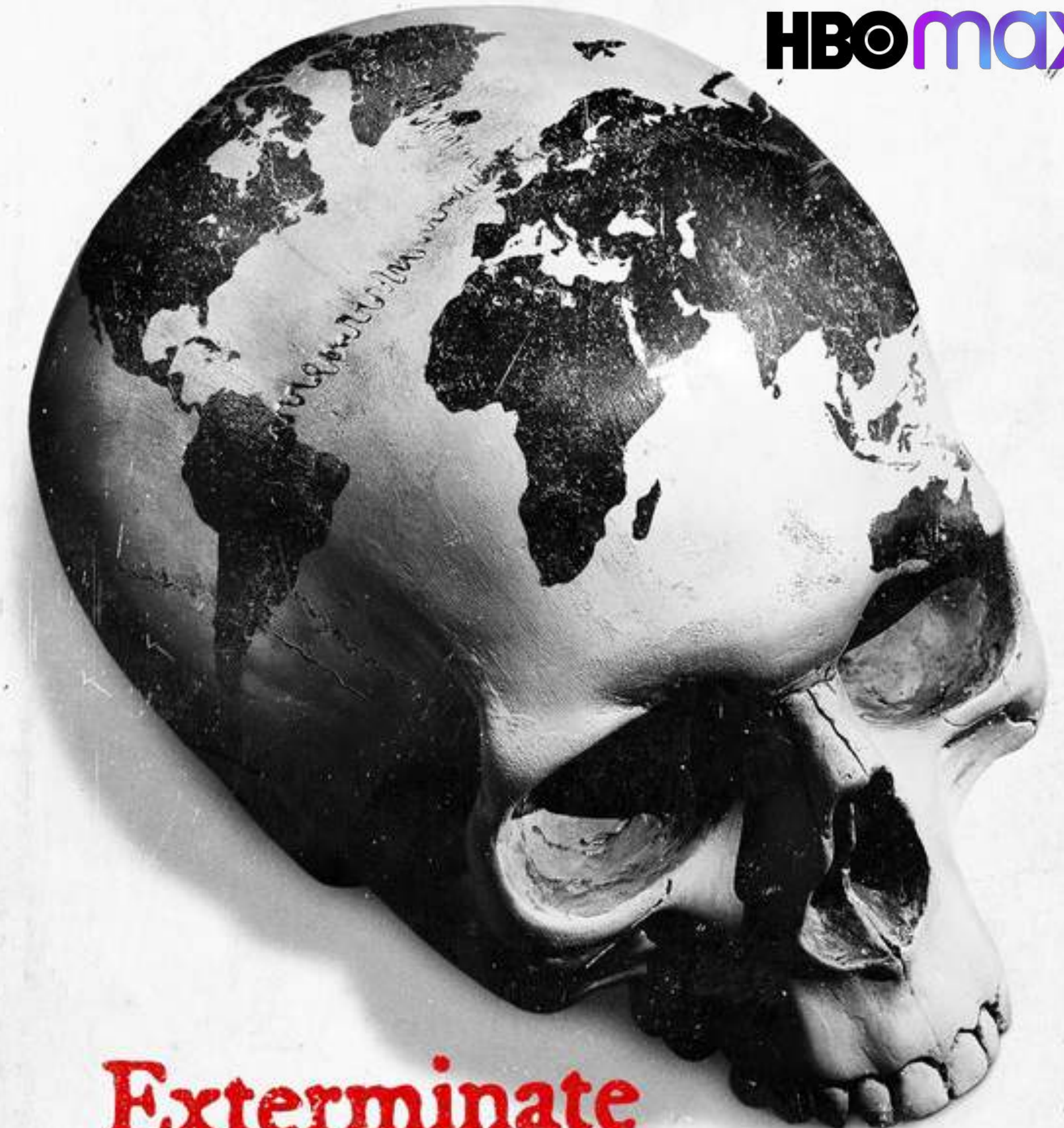
WHAT IS COLONIALISM?

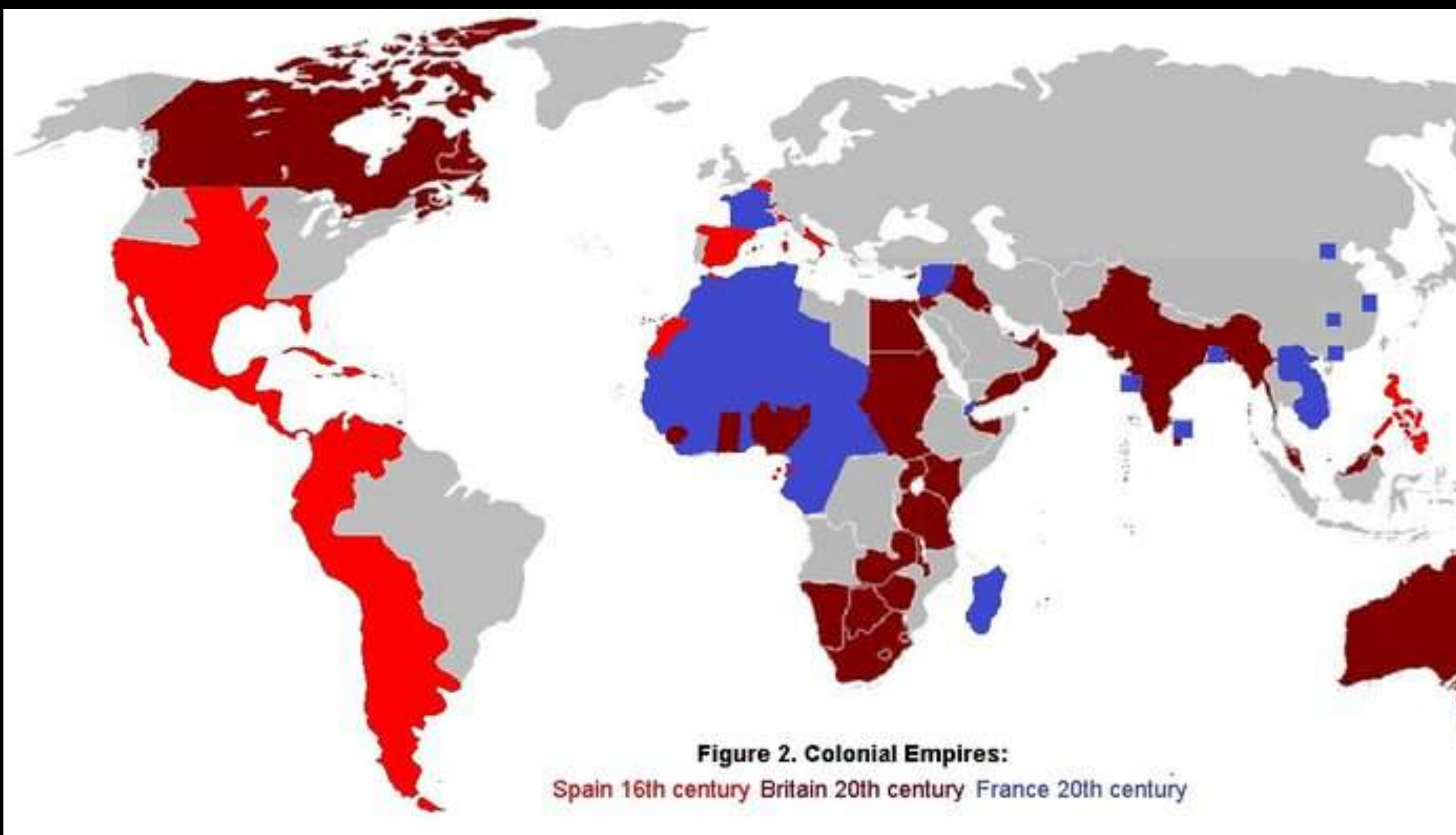
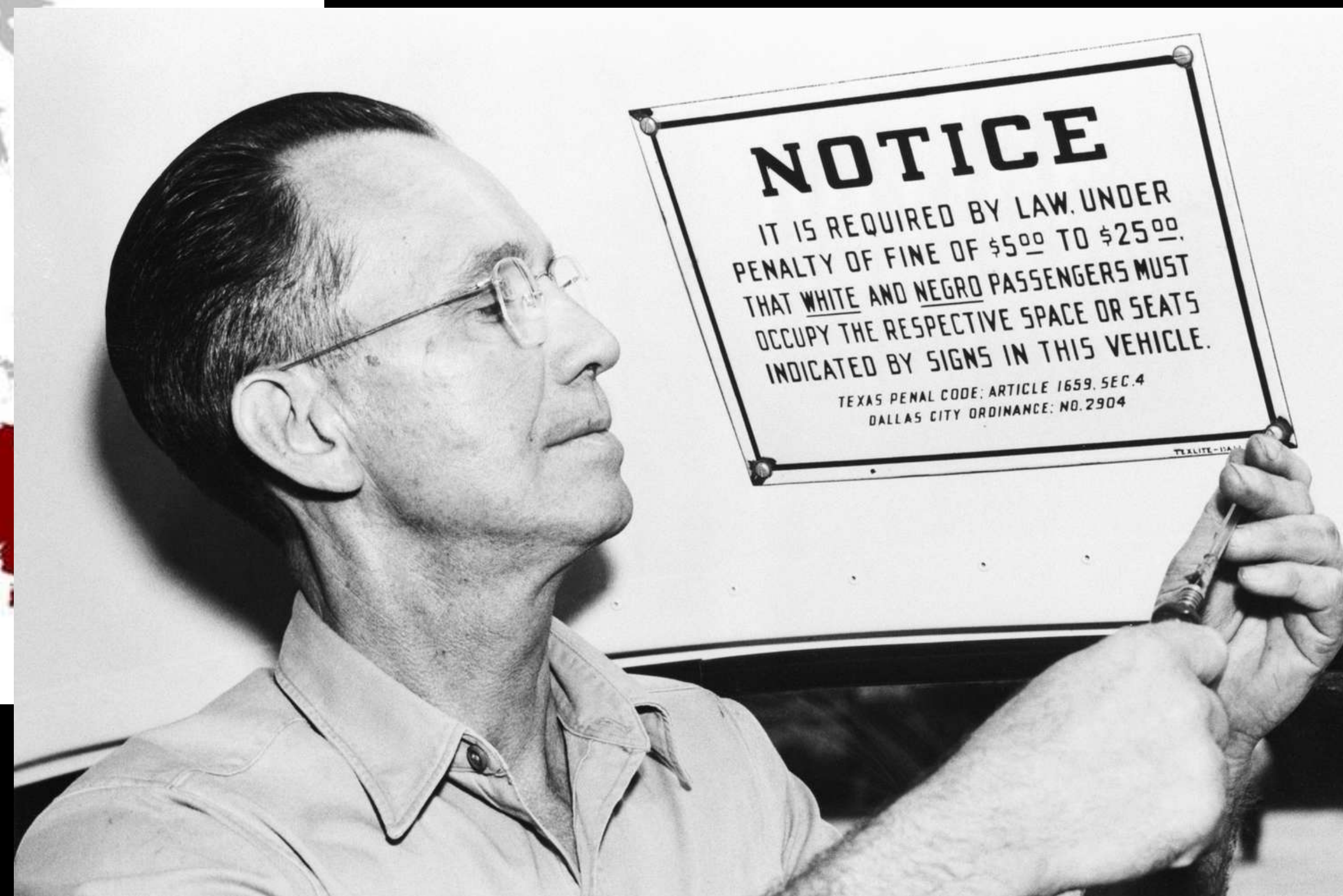


Figure 2. Colonial Empires:

As example: the **United States, Canada & Australia**.

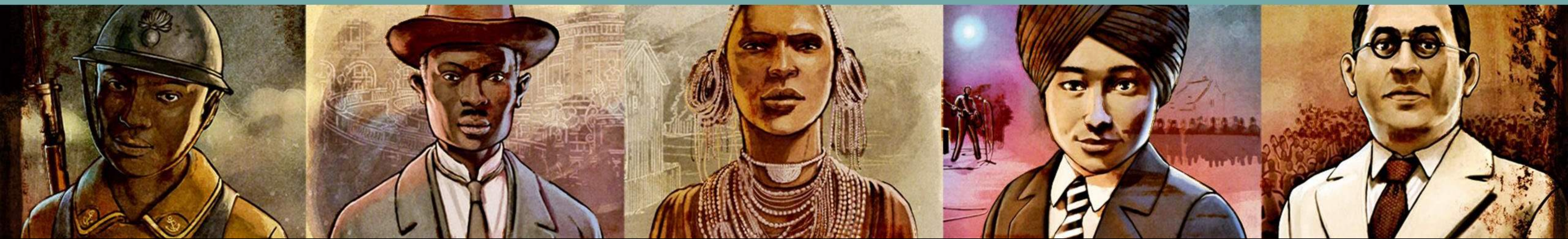

« the process of freeing an institution, sphere of activity, society, etc. from the **legal systems** & **cultural/social effects** of Colonization. »

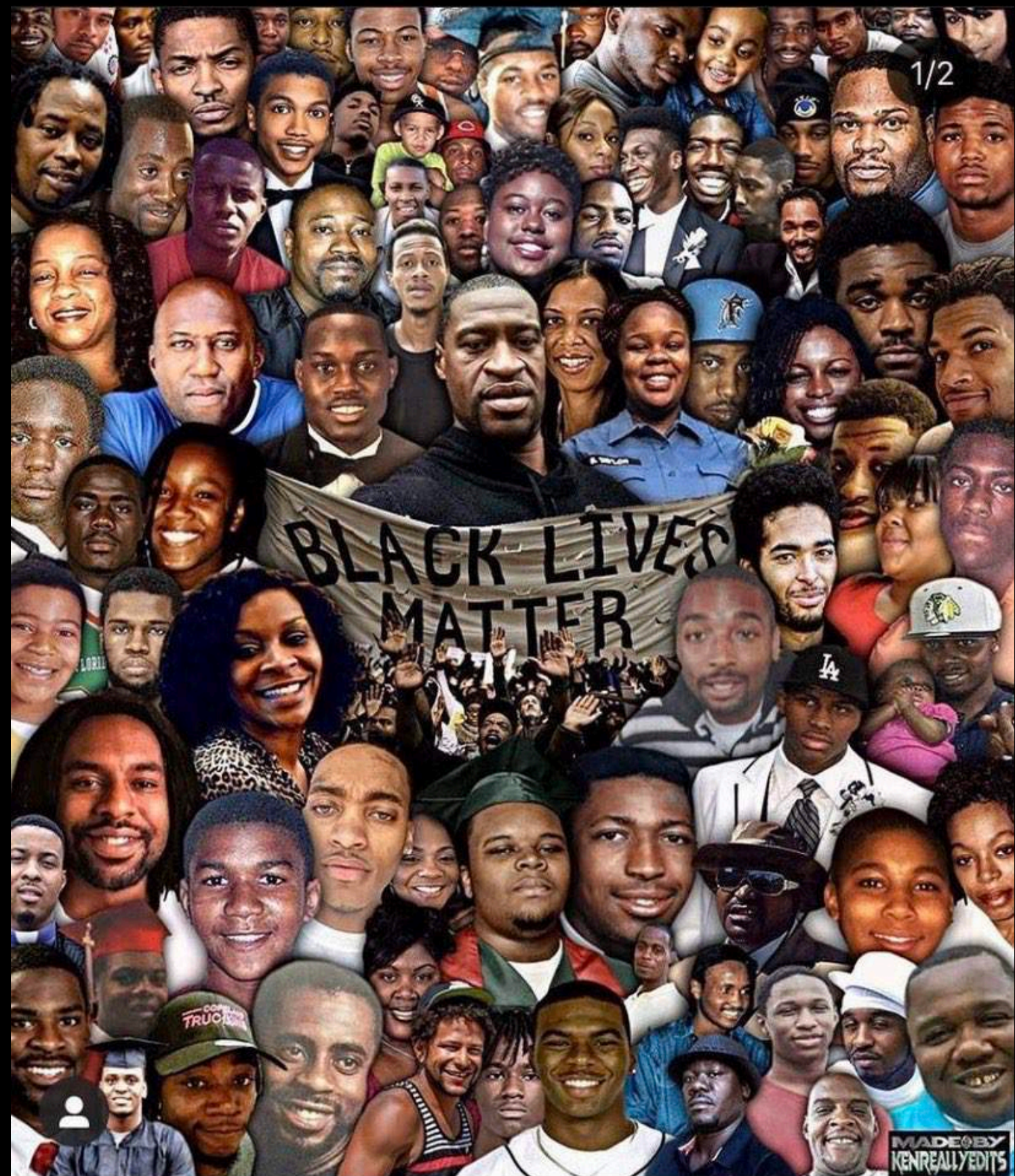

Neo-colonialism

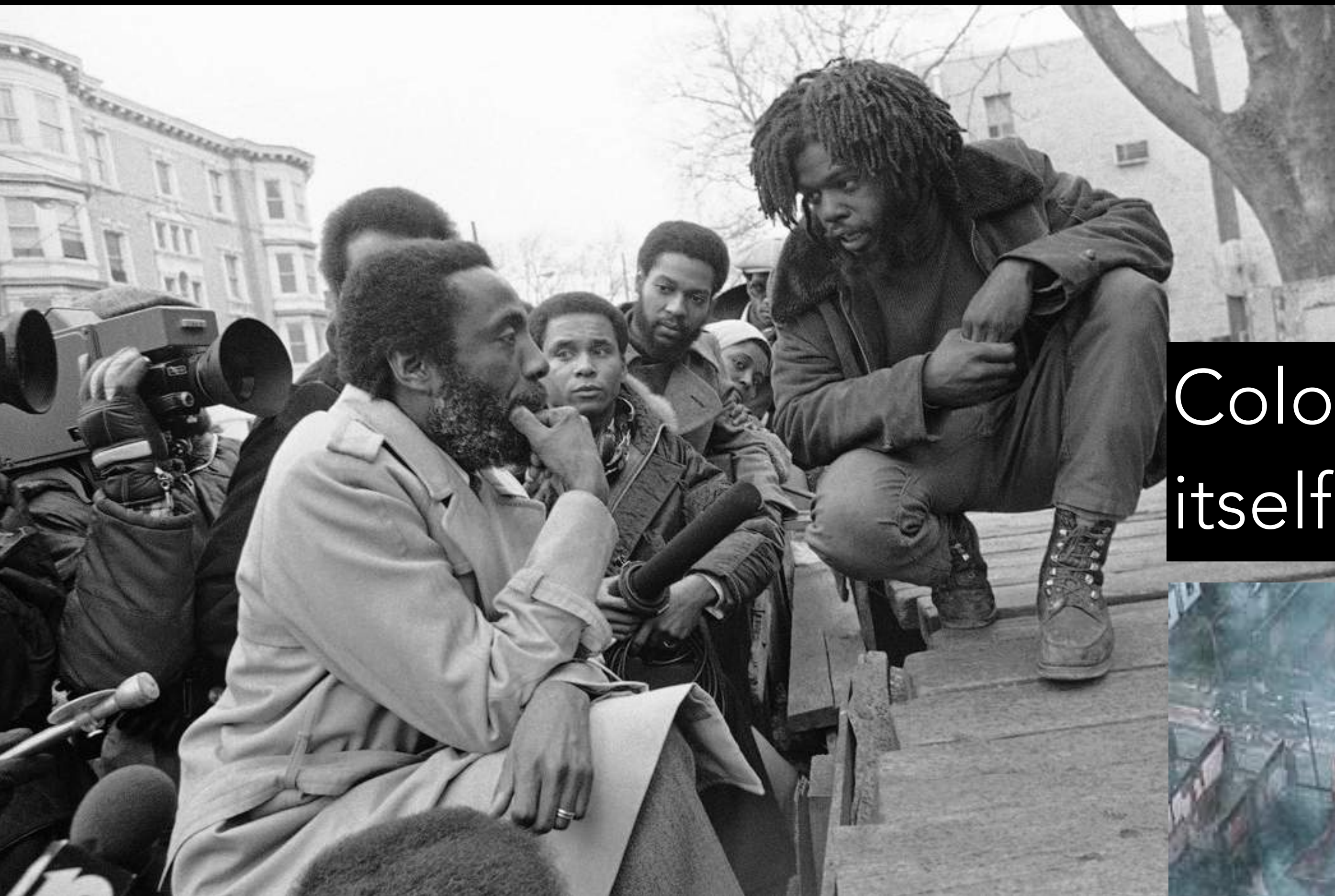
Practice of using globalization, capitalism & cultural imperialism to influence a developing country in lieu of direct military control (**imperialism**) or indirect political control (**hegemony**)

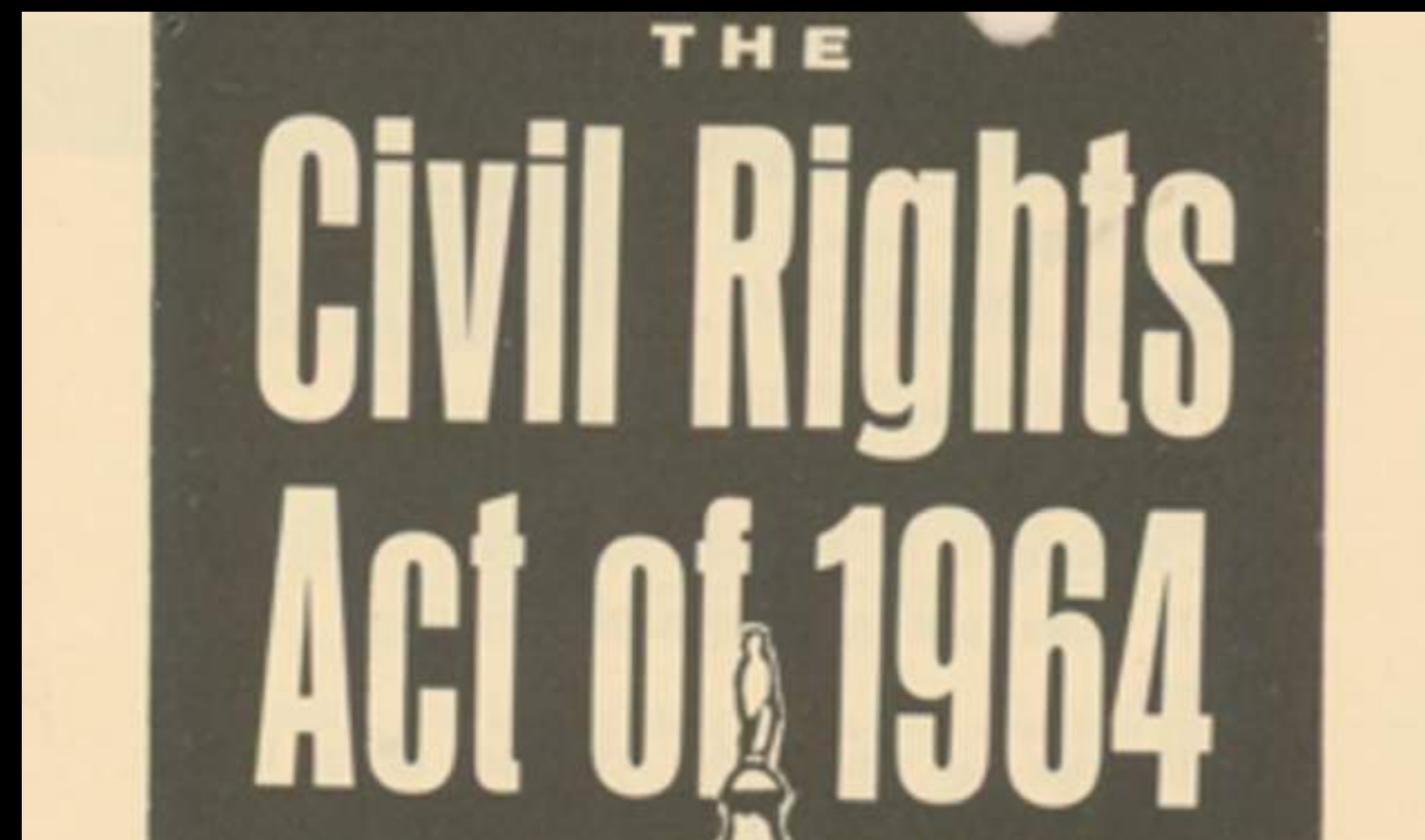




OUR ARENA IS IN POLICY & PROCEDURE:
