# Asia Plays Pivotal Role In Tourism Growth In The APAC REGION

The International visitor arrivals (IVAs) to Asia Pacific are expected to increase from 619 million in 2024 to 762 million in 2026, with a recovery rate of 111.6% compared to the 2019 level.

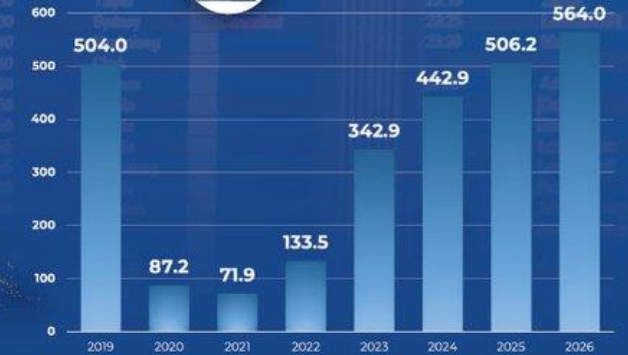
**ASIA WILL LEAD THE RECOVERY, WITH VISITOR ARRIVALS REACHING 564.0 MILLION,** followed by the Americas with 167.7 million and the Pacific with 30.4 million by 2026, highlighting the region's resilience and growing potential as a travel destination.

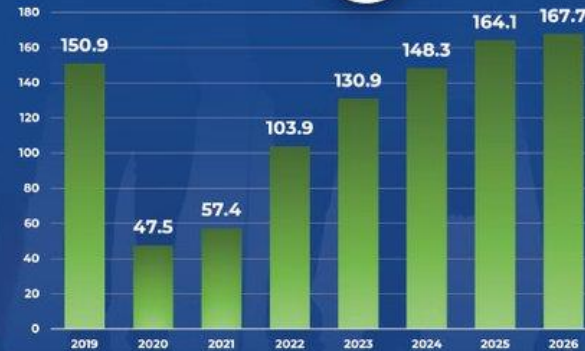
## IVAs INTO THREE ASIA PACIFIC DESTINATION REGIONS MEDIUM SCENARIO, 2019 TO 2026 mns



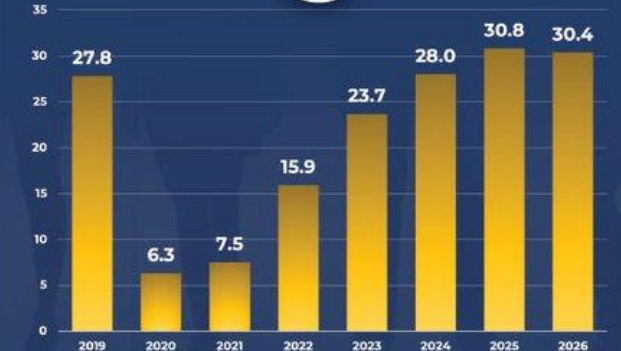

# THE STATE OF AIRPORT INDUSTRY

As of January 2023, there are 425 known projects across existing airports globally, of which, 155 known projects (36%) are in the Asia Pacific region, with current committed investment of USD 209 billion.

This puts Asia Pacific at the forefront, leading the way in the number of projects and the investment committed to existing and new airports

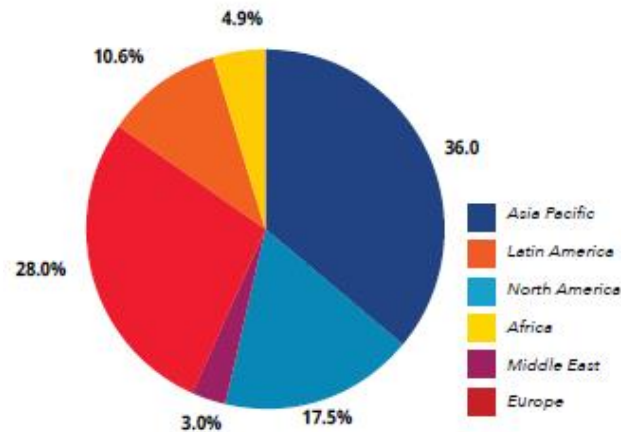


Chart 2: The ratio of projects by region

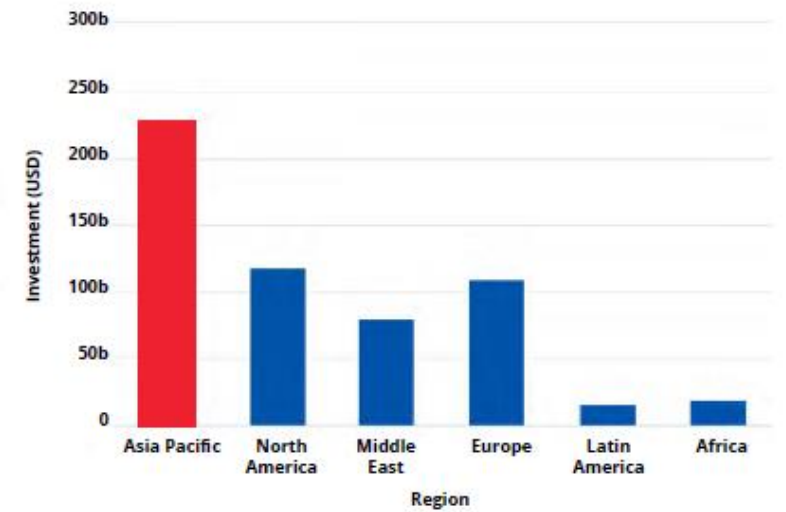


Chart 3: The investment value of projects

## THE RUSH TO BUILD MORE AIRPORTS IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

Vietnam is leading the way, with plans to build 30 airports, while six other countries – Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, Cambodia, Indonesia and the Philippines – are either planning new airports or expanding existing ones.

The investment should result in a significant expansion in passenger and cargo capacity in the region. That growth is much needed, given that total air passenger travel in Southeast Asia is expected to reach 653 million people by 2030, nearly doubling from 2023.
