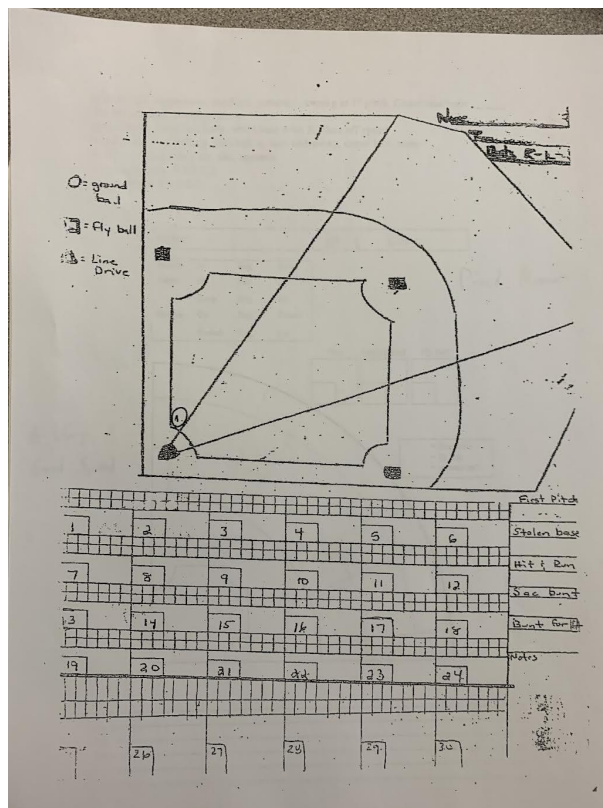

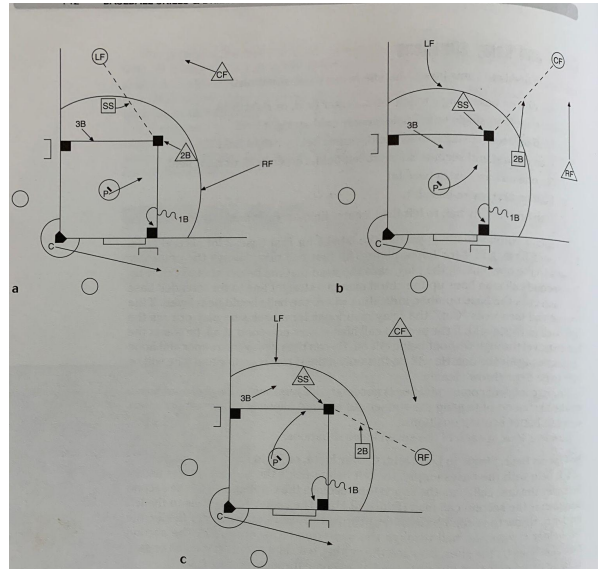
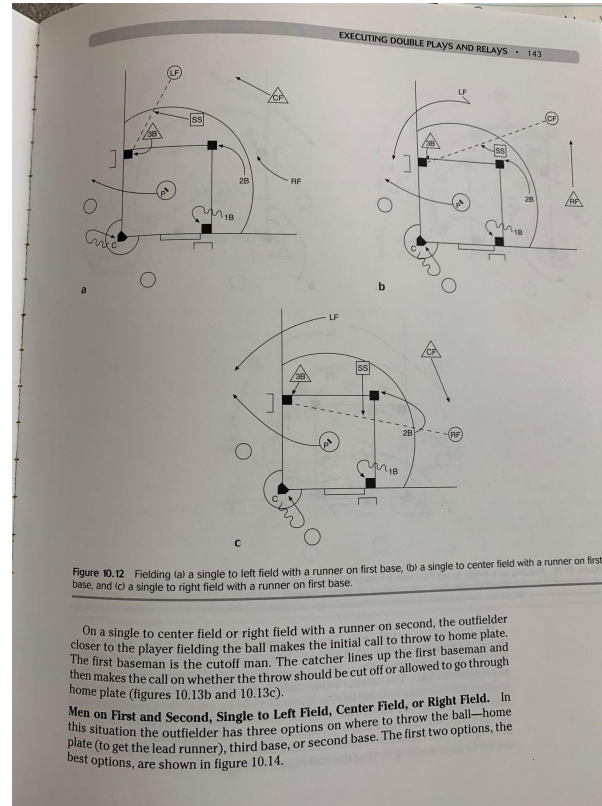


Figure 10.11 Fielding (a) a single to left field with no runners on base, (b) a single to center field with no runners on base, and (c) a single to right field with no runners on base.

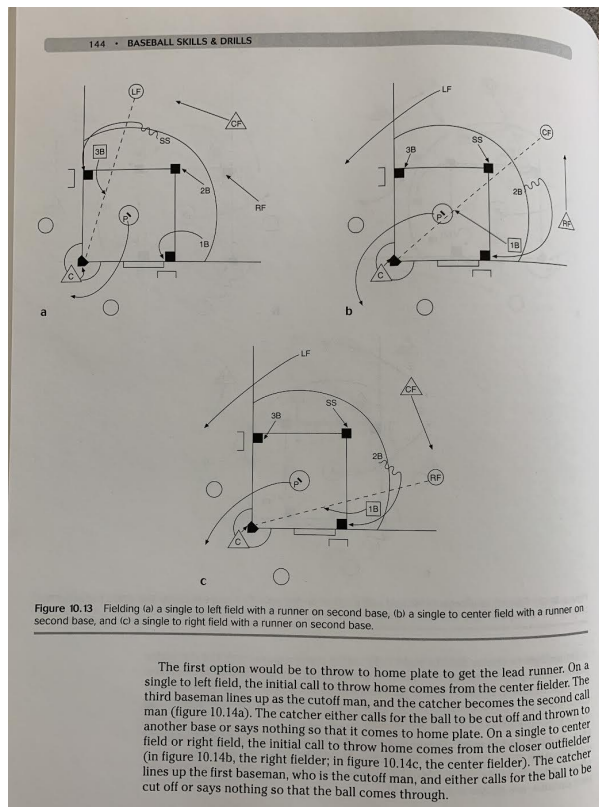
to throw toward third base. The shortstop is the cutoff man, and the third baseman lines him up. The third baseman then makes the call on whether the ball should be cut off or allowed to travel through to third base (figure 10.12).

Man on Second, Single to Left Field, Center Field, or Right Field. On a single to left field with a runner on second, the center fielder makes the initial call for the left fielder to throw the ball to home plate. The third baseman is the cutoff man. The catcher lines up the third baseman in a straight line to home plate. The catcher calls whether the throw should be cut off or allowed to go through to home plate (figure 10.13a).

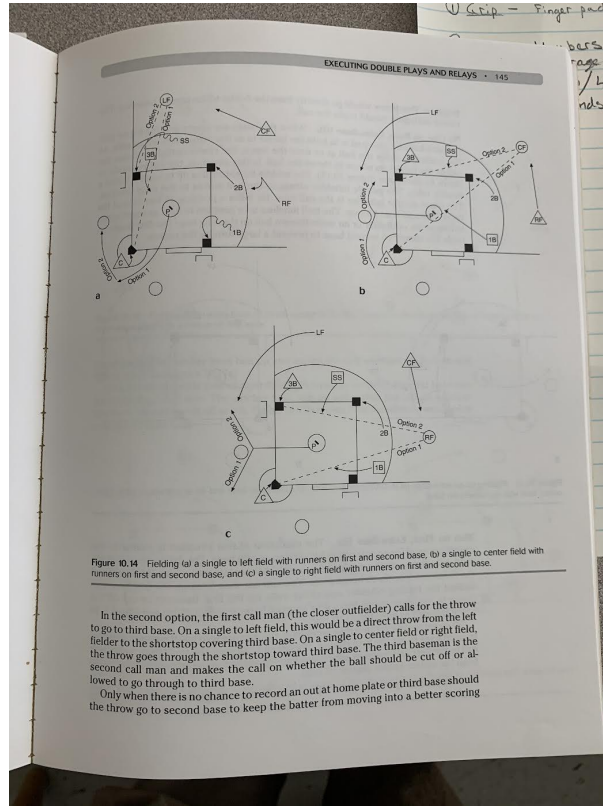

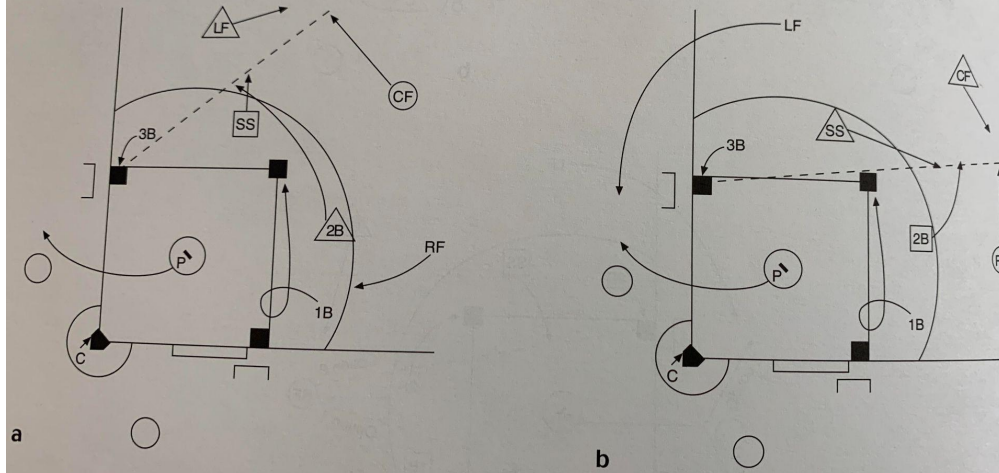
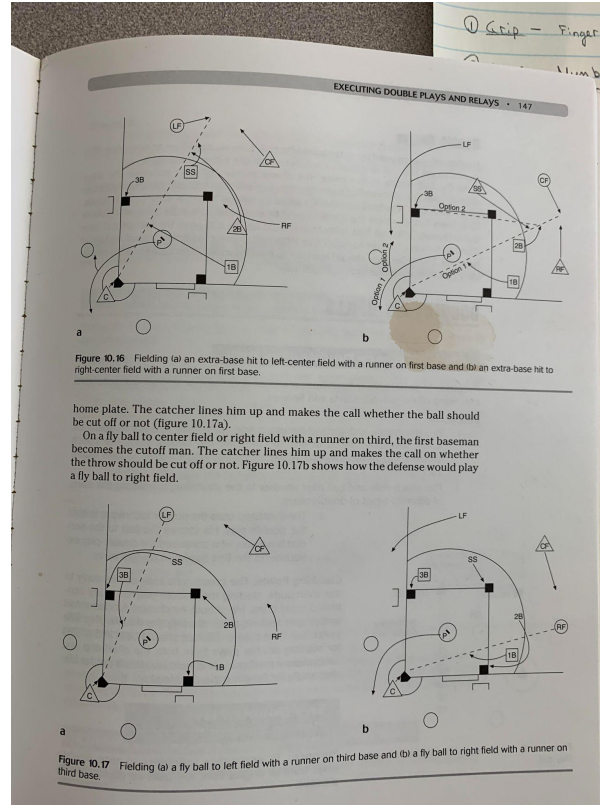
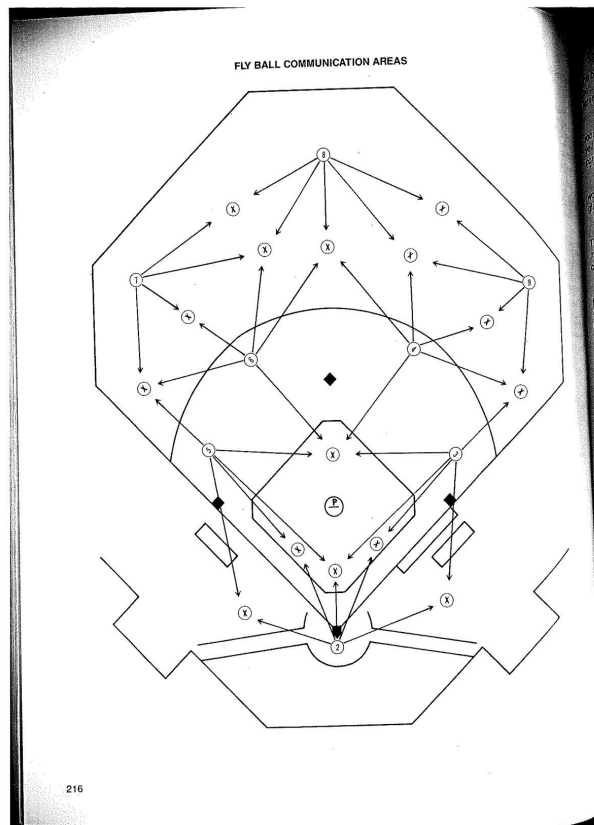


Figure 10.15 Fielding (a) an extra-base hit to left-center field with no runners on base and (b) an extra-base hit to right-center field with no runners on base.

can to the fielder or where to throw the ball. In this situation, the call man makes the throw to third base (figure 10.15). The middle infielders line up in what is usually a double relay. The middle infielder closer to the ball moves to the relay position. The other middle infielder is the call man. He takes a position 15 feet behind the relay man and lines him up. The trail infielder is in position to field an overthrown ball from the outfielder or an underthrown ball on the long hop. The first baseman trails the runner to second base to prevent a large turn by the runner.

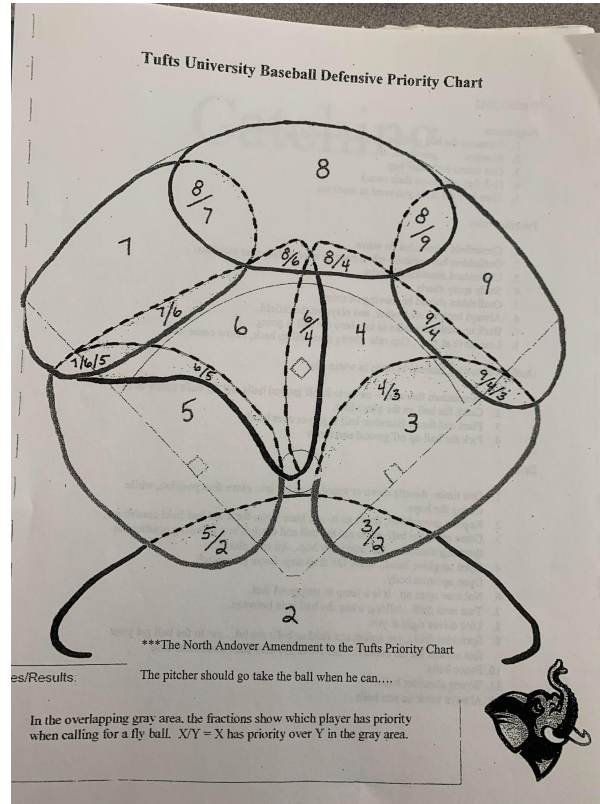
