CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Registration & Tee-Off Times

Registration starts at 9:00AM

Ceremonial Tee-off at 10:30 AM (Tournament Tee-off immediately flows)

White Tee - 55 and up (seniors)

Blue Tee - 54 and below

Red Tee - Ladies

Format

The team and individual competitions shall be on the best net score using System 36.

Gimme at eighteen (18) inches

Pick-up at Quadruple Bogey

Team Competition

Each association, ACI, BSP, FINEX and MART, can field up to **10 players to represent their team with the best 5 net scores to be counted.**

The association is responsible for submitting the names of their players on or before **October 10, 2024**. After this date, any changes in the team members must be made known to the organizing committee and approved accordingly. Team members can be changed before the start of the competition upon the approval of the organizing committee and the captains of each team.

Individual Competition

Winners will be awarded a trophy:

Low Gross Champion

Low Net Champion

Class A, B & C - Champion and Runner-up

Ladies Champion

Fun Hole:

Longest Drive

*In case of ties, the following sequence of tie breaker will be used **for both team and individual competitions** until the tie is broken:*

a. Lower total gross score

b. Most number of eagles, or if still tied, by

c. Most number of birdies, or if still tied, by

d. Most number of pars, or if still tied, by

e. Most number of bogeys, or if still tied, by

f. Lower total gross score in the back nine; Lower total gross score in the front nine or if still tied, by

g. Hole-by-hole gross count back starting with hole #18 going backwards.

Rules of Play: Shall be conducted in accordance with the National Golf Association of the Philippines and the Local Rules of Mount Malarayat Golf and Country Club.

Mulligans

Php600.00 for 2. Only one Mulligan for the front nine and one Mulligan for the back nine. They can be used anywhere except on the putting green.

Flight Composition

Flights will be prepared by the organizing team.

Cross Scoring/Scorecard Procedure

For the team competition, each player or his caddy must record the gross score of another player in their flight. At the end of play, all players must:

- Check hole by hole scores for accuracy.
- Sign the scorecard of cross-scoring player and countersign his own scorecard.
- Submit scorecards to the Committee as soon as possible after the end of play.

Raffle Prizes

Physical presence is required to be able to win any of the major prizes. If a name is called twice, he/she will be given the choice on which prize to keep. The other prize will then be raffled off. However, everyone will have the chance to win the grand prize even if he has already won a minor prize.

Awarding Ceremonies

Awarding of trophies and raffle prizes will follow immediately after the last score card has been submitted and tallied.

Official Arbiters

Rules clarification shall be directed to the tournament organizers. Their decision shall be considered final.
