Executive Summary

The NM-ICPS, a National Mission on Interdisciplinary Cyber Physical Systems (NM-ICPS) being implemented by the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India, has established 25 Technology Innovation Hubs (TIHs) across the nation, housed within premier academic institutes. These TIHs are dedicated to advancing technology development and translation, fostering human resource and skill development, promoting entrepreneurship and start-ups, and facilitating international collaborative research endeavours in cyber physical systems (CPS).

The National Workshop on Technology Innovation in Cyber Physical Systems (TIPS) conducted by the NM- ICPS, DST is a bi-annual workshop wherein each of the 25 TIHs demonstrate the progress and achievements made. It is a platform for all the stakeholders including Government, Startups, Investors, Academia, and Industry to interact, exchange ideas and witness the cutting-edge technology development in CPS domain.

Investor Pitch

In view of the national mission to promote innovation and entrepreneurship in the CPS domain, the TIPS 4.0 workshop will also feature a 'Investor Pitch' event wherein a bunch ofDeepTech startups working in CPSdomain will be pitching to esteemed VCs and Angel Investors for funding. The Startup Pitches will run in parallel across 3 tracks based on the funding amount being raised viz.,

- 1. Micro: 50 Lakhs 1 Crore
- 2. Mini: 1 Crore 2 Crore
- 3. Mega: Above 2 Crore

The DeepTech startups pitching at the TIPS 4.0 will be from the following 5 thematic areas of Agriculture, Healthcare, Defence, Environment, Infrastructure.

In addition to Startup Pitches, the TIPS 4.0 workshop will also feature a Tech Expo wherein the startups will exhibit and demonstrate their cutting-edge technology to stakeholders from the Government and Investor community.
