1. Create an account
2. Give your consent
3. Agree to share your electronic health records
4. Complete the Consent to Get DNA Results
5. Answer health surveys
6. Have your measurements taken (height, weight, blood pressure, etc.) and give blood and urine samples, if asked

After completing these steps, you'll receive \$25. It may be in the form of cash, a gift card, or an electronic voucher. You will not receive compensation for providing your saliva.
