FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

GENERAL DRAFT DAY QUESTIONS

- How much does Draft Day cost schools?
 There is no cost to the schools other than related to providing transportation to and from the event.
- 2. Which seniors should I recruit to sign up for interviews at Draft Day?

 You are encouraged to recruit seniors who are leaders in their schools and who are interested in, or plan to enter technical careers after high school, after a technical certification program, or while doing both.
- 3. How many students should participate in interviews at Draft Day?

 Approximately 20% of your graduating class. We want students who are genuinely interested over students who are just exploring ideas. Idea seekers should go to the Expo. Seniors registering for interviews should be those looking for jobs immediately upon graduation.
- 4. How many students should I bring to the Career Expo? All juniors and seniors are invited to participate in the Expo.
- 5. Can my school attend multiple Draft Day events? Yes, but we recommend students only attend one draft day, so if you have students interested in one Draft Day over another, we recommend you sign them up for only the draft day they are interested in.
- 6. What companies will be at each Draft Day event?
 Participating Schools and Companies will be updated on the website weekly as registrations are confirmed.

REGISTRATION QUESTIONS

- I am the point of contact for multiple schools will I get a registration link for each? You will likely receive
 one registration link. When selecting your ticket, choose the number of tickets for the number of schools
 you represent.
- 2. The registration form requires a photo. Do I upload a photo of myself? No. Please upload your school's logo.
- 3. It's asking if we need lunch. Do you have the schedule? What do we say? If your students will miss their lunch period due to Draft Day attendance, please choose 'yes' so Be Pro Be Proud can provide lunch for them. If your students will not miss lunch, will bring a lunch, or you have plans to purchase lunch for your students, please choose 'no.'

YOUSCIENCE:

- How do educators gain YouScience access? YouScience will reach out to registered schools to make this connection or you can contact our YouScience representative, Marisa Littlefield, direct at marisa. littlefield@youscience.com.
- 2. How do we register Seniors? Once the school is registered, YouScience will reach out and walk you through your admin page and how to add students to give them access to the assessment. They can answer other questions you have about YouScience at that time.
- 3. Can I have other students take YouScience? Only seniors participating in Draft Day interviews are allowed to take YouScience. Be Pro Be Proud will only cover the cost of YouScience Assessments for Seniors who sign up for Draft Day. YouScience is only for Seniors once they have registered for Draft Day.
- 4. My seniors previously took YouScience. Do they have to take it again? Anyone who has taken YouScience (ever) will not have to re-take it. For example, if a student took YouScience in middle school, they would not have to re-take it.
- 5. Can you explain how YouScience is used in the BPBP process?

 Seniors' YouScience results will assist them in preparing for their interviews by providing them with an indepth analysis of their strengths as well as key components to share with an interviewer. Be Pro Be Proud uses the results in interview matching and scheduling.
- 6. Will there be supplemental materials provided to our schools to help promote and complete the prework for Draft Day (specifically referring to YouScience)? Yes.
