The PDPA aims to protect individuals' personal data by regulating the collection, use, and disclosure of such data. It defines personal data as any information that can directly or indirectly identify a person.

Consent and Individuals' Rights

The law requires businesses to obtain explicit consent from individuals before processing their personal data. Individuals have the right to access their data, correct it, object to certain processing, and request the deletion of their data.

Security Measures and Penalties

Businesses must implement appropriate security measures to protect personal data and inform individuals in case of a data breach. Non-compliance with the PDPA can result in financial penalties and imprisonment for those responsible.
