ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EL DORADO PRIDE FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be: El Dorado PRIDE Foundation, Inc. The acronym PRIDE shall stand for: Providing Research and Industrial Development Through Education.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EL DORADO PRIDE FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, within the meaning of § 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (the "Code"). The corporation's primary purposes are as follows:

ARTICLE IV

(a) Provide for the education and instruction of the public, **inside and outside** of El Dorado, Arkansas on subjects useful to or beneficial to the **City of El Dorado and surrounding areas**;

ARTICLE IV

(b) To aid, assist and foster the planning, replanning, development, renewal, redevelopment and improvement of El Dorado, Arkansas for the purpose of combating community deterioration, lessening neighborhood tensions, and lessening the burdens of government;

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EL DORADO PRIDE FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE IV

(c) To assist in educational activities, inside El Dorado, Arkansas and outside El Dorado, Arkansas, for the purpose of educating the public as to the nature, characteristics and conditions prevailing in the community, for the purpose of providing relief for the poor and under-privileged through **employment and educational opportunities**; and assist, when in furtherance of the foregoing, **the erection and maintenance of public buildings or works for such purposes**;

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EL DORADO PRIDE FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE IV

(d) To receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, and, subject to the restrictions hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole, or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, scientific, religious and educational purposes.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EL DORADO PRIDE FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE XIII

The business of the corporation shall be conducted by the Board of Directors who shall direct the affairs of the corporation. The Board of Directors of the corporation shall be the President/CEO of the El Dorado Chamber of Commerce and the persons serving in the following four (4) positions of the Executive Committee of the El Dorado Chamber of Commerce, as duly elected or appointed, from time to time by the El Dorado Chamber of Commerce:

1. Chair;
2. Chair Elect;
3. Secretary ;
4. Treasure; and

At no time, shall the number of directors consist of less than three (3) or more individuals.
