ISSUE 3 - TERM LIMITS

Would Cap legislative terms at:

3 two-year terms in House

2 four-year terms in Senate

Lifetime cap of 10 years

Retroactive to 1993

80% of current legislature could
not run for re-election in 2020

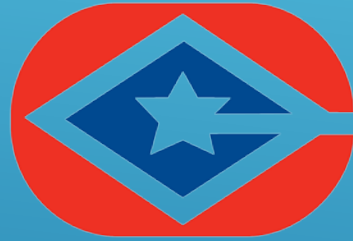
