


2019 Copper 5 Honors Awards Luncheon Wednesday, November 10, 2021

Technical Sergeant Charity Stuart is assigned as an active duty guardsman, to the 161st Maintenance Squadron, 161st Maintenance Group, 161st Air Refueling Wing, Goldwater Air National Guard Base, in Phoenix, Arizona. Subject Matter Expert training and mentoring newly assigned personnel. She ensures the directions and policies of the commander are understood and carried out and that Airmen are dedicated to the mission.

Sergeant Stuart works with other enlisted leaders and First Sergeants to oversee the readiness, training, health, morale, welfare, and quality of life of assigned personnel. She is responsible for the maintenance and inspections
