2020 Informal Senior Officials Meeting Report



OVERVIEW

Surrounded by blue seas and carpeted with lush forest, Malaysia's Langkawi Island served as a dramatic backdrop for the Informal Senior Officials' Meeting (ISOM), the first of more than 100 meetings and workshops that will held in Malaysia between now and November of next year. 2020 will mark Malaysia's second hosting of APEC, the first being in 1998. Several economies have hosted APEC twice, but Prime Minister Mahathir will become the only APEC Leader to have personally chaired the forum multiple times. When he returned to the post of prime minister in May of 2018, Mahathir indicated an intent to step down after two years. However, a December 12 announcement stating that he would extend his remit through the end of 2020 has put him on course to reach this particular APEC milestone.

Leading the discussions at the ISOM was Mr. Hairil Yahri Yaacob, a senior official with the Ministry of International Trade and Industry who was tapped by Malaysia's government to lead APEC 2020. In Langkawi, Hairil presented Malaysia's ambitious agenda - details outlined below – which ranges from tackling the massive task of finding consensus on a post-2020 vision for APEC, to considering indicators of economic health that could supplement traditional measures like GDP. Much of the rationale behind the 2020 agenda was foreshadowed in Prime Minister Mahathir's speech at the 2018 APEC CEO Summit where he touched on the need for developing economies to focus on policies to deal with disruption, ensure equality and promote shared prosperity. Evidence of Malaysia's domestic focus on "shared prosperity" is apparent not only in the overall theme of APEC 2020, but throughout the specific deliverables it has proposed, as well.

The ISOM was also an opportunity for APEC Business Advisory Council (ABAC) Chair for 2020 Dato Rohana Tan Sri Mahmoud to present ABAC's priorities for next year. Details on the Council's proposed work under the theme of *Integration, Inclusion and Innovation* appear below. In 2020, Nate Gatten of American Airlines will be joined by Peggy Johnson of Microsoft in representing the United States on ABAC. Peggy will serve as chair of ABAC's Digital and Innovation Working Group which will focus on the policy implications of artificial intelligence among other emerging issues.

Malaysia executed the logistical elements of the ISOM, including transportation, on-site meeting operations, and social events in a remarkably efficient manner. Organizers even deployed facial recognition technology to manage venue access. This is likely a first for APEC. Successful execution this early in the APEC year bodes well for Malaysia's capacity to manage the more complicated arrangements required for APEC Leaders' Week in November.

NCAPEC's upcoming Executive Roundtable will be an excellent opportunity for member companies to learn more about Malaysia's APEC and ABAC priorities and engage directly with Mr. Hairil and Dato Rohana who will both be in attendance.
