#### Welcome

Welcome to the President's Report to the Finland Australia Chamber of Commerce Inc. (FACC) 2020!

### **Membership Status**

The Chamber's membership has increased since the last AGM in 2019. While we had 45 members last year, this number has now risen to 47. We welcome Glaston Finland as platinum member and Peikko Australia Pty Ltd as gold member of the Chamber.

The Chamber acknowldges that due to COVID-19 restrictions there have been less face to face member events since March 2020 than we would normally offer our members. In view of this and in order to reduce the financial burden on our members during these challenging times the board has decided to offer a one-off 50% reduction of membership fees for the calendar year 2021. You will receive a special code together with your renewal notice later this year which will allow you to take advantage of this benefit.

## Member Activities in 2019/2020

The **Annual General Meeting** on 24 October 2019 in Sydney was hosted by Kalmar at Port Botany. The Chamber is very grateful to Kalmar for arranging an escorted private tour of the Patrick's Automated Container Terminal immediately before the AGM. Our members were able to see the Kalmar port automation in operation.









The AGM included a very interesting briefing by Tim Goulain from the FACC member European Australian Business Council (EABC) on current European trade issues and the status of the Australian Free Trade negotiations.

By tradition the Chamber participated in the annual **Cruise with the Europeans** in Sydney on the 14 November 2019, co-organised by various European Chambers. There were 12 FACC guests present at the spectacular 2-hour cruise, among over 600 representatives from the European business community in Sydney.







On 6 December 2019 the **FACC Brisbane Chapter** put on a very successful Finnish Independence Day dinner at the Summit Restaurant at Mt Coot-tha. Our members enjoyed the magnificent views over Brisbane as well as a three course dinner. The Ambassador of Finland H.E. Lars Backström and Mrs Brigitta Backström were the special guests of the evening.

The FACC Melbourne Chapter participated in the Nordic Engagement Networking lunch on 5 February 2020 at Denmark House in Melbourne. Our members were able to enjoy traditional smørebrød lunch with fellow Nordic business people from Denmark, Norway and Sweden.

As in previous years, FACC held **member networking drinks** for our members and friends at the Sir Stamford Hotel in Sydney. The Chamber organises this get-together on a quarterly basis and the first event for 2020 was held on 12 March 2020.





Unfortunately, the Chamber had to cancel the networking drinks for the remainder of 2020 due to COVID-19 restrictions.

The highlight of the past year in Sydney was the **Independence Day Dinner** at Blanca Bar & Dining at Bondi on 5 December 2019. Our members enjoyed a Finnish inspired menu which was especially created for the occasion by Tomi Björk, Finland's most cherished chef and restauranteur. scheduled for 4 March 2021 and we hope to finally be able to hold another fun day on the course for our members.
