INSTRUCTION OF THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS NUMBER 01 OF 2021

REGARDING

ENFORCEMENT ON THE LIMITATION OF ACTIVITIES TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF THE CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS

Following the explanation of Government policies in the context of controlling the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Covid-19) for the safety of the people, including through consistency in compliance with the Covid-19 health protocols and regulation of enforcement of limitations on community activities.

Observing the development of the Covid-19 pandemic that has occurred recently, in which several states in the world have restricted the mobility of the community, and with the new variant of the Covid-19 virus, measures to control the Covid-19 pandemic are needed.

The measures that have been taken by the Central Government and Regional Governments by issuing several regulations based on Article 7 and Article 8 of Law Number 12 of 2011 regarding the Formation of Laws and Regulations, as amended by Law Number 15 of 2019 regarding Amendment to Law Number 12 of 2011 regarding the Formation of Laws and Regulations, including in the category of "Regulations" in the form of Government Regulations, Presidential Regulations, Ministerial Regulations, Regional Regulations, Head of Region Regulations, and several policies in the form of Instructions and Circular Letters in the context of handling the Covid-19 pandemic.

The previous measures that have been taken by the Government were to establish a policy to regulate the travel of persons/foreign citizens to Indonesia by temporarily banning the entry of foreigners from January 1, 2021, to January 14, 2021.

For consistency in improving the control of the spread of the Covid-19 pandemic, by observing the provisions of the laws and regulations, it is necessary to take quick, precise, focused and integrated measures between the Central Government and Regional Governments, it is therefore instructed:

Especially to:

- 1. The Governor of DKI Jakarta;
- 2. The Governor of West Java and the Regent/Mayor with priority territories of Bogor Regency, Bekasi Regency, Cimahi Regency, Bogor City, Depok City, Bekasi City, and Bandung Raya territory;
- 3. The Governor of Banten and the Regent/Mayor with priority territories of Tangerang Regency, Tangerang City and South Tangerang City;
- 4. The Governor of Central Java and the Regent/Mayor with priority territories of Semarang Raya, Banyumas Raya and Surakarta City and their surroundings;
- The Governor of the Special Region of Yogyakarta and the Regent/Mayor with priority territories of Yogyakarta City, Bantul Regency, Gunung Kidul Regency, Sleman Regency and Kulon Progo Regency;
- 6. The Governor of East Java and the Regent/Mayor with priority territories of Surabaya Raya and Malang Raya; and
- 7. The Governor of Bali with priority territories of Badung Regency and Denpasar City and their surroundings.

to regulate the imposition of limitations on community activities that have the potential to cause the transmission of the Covid-19 virus.

SECOND

The regulation on the enforcement of limitations as referred to in the FIRST Dictum consists of:

- a. limiting the workplace/office by implementing Work From Home (WFH) by 75% (seventy five percent) and Work From Office (WFO) by 25% (twenty five percent) with more stringent enforcement of health protocols;
- b. conducting online teaching and learning activities;
- for essential sectors related to the basic needs of the community, they may operate 100% (one hundred percent) by regulating operating hours, capacity, and more stringent implementation of health protocols;
- d. regulating the enforcement of limitations of:



- restaurant activities (dine-in by 25% (twenty five percent)) and for food services via delivery/take-out are still permitted in accordance with restaurant operating hours; and
- 2. restriction of operating hours for shopping centers/malls until 19.00 WIB,
- allowing construction activities to operate 100% (one hundred percent) with more stringent implementation of health protocols;
- f. allowing places of worship to be implemented with a capacity limitation arrangement of 50% (fifty percent) with more stringent implementation of health protocols;

The scope of the enforcement of these activity limitations as referred to in the SECOND Dictum shall include provinces/regencies/cities which fulfill the following elements:

- a. The mortality rate is above the national average mortality rate;
- b. The recovery rate is below the national average recovery rate:
- c. The active case rate is above the average national active case rate; and
- d. The Bed Occupancy Rate (BOR) for Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and isolation rooms is above 70% (seventy percent).

The regulation of the enforcement of limitation as referred to in the SECOND Dictum shall be carried out in all provinces in the Java and Bali Island territories with the consideration that all provinces in the region fulfill one of the elements or more than 4 (four) parameters as stated in the THIRD Dictum and the Governor as referred to in the FIRST Dictum may determine other districts/cities in their territories, taking into account the four parameters and other considerations to strengthen efforts to control Covid-19.

In addition to regulating the enforcement of limitations as referred to in the SECOND Dictum, these regions shall further intensify health protocols (using masks properly and correctly, washing hands using soap or hand sanitizer, maintaining distance and avoiding crowds that have the potential to cause transmission), in addition to strengthening tracking capabilities, tracing system and management, improvement of treatment including improving

health facilities (beds, Intensive Care Unit (ICU) rooms, and isolation/guarantine areas).

SIXTH

The enforcement regulation as referred to in the SECOND Dictum shall take effect from January 11 to January 25, 2021, therefore the head regions are required to carry out monitoring and coordination meetings with all relevant stakeholders, periodically, daily, weekly, and monthly, to enforce limitations and other efforts and, if necessary, can make a Head of Region Regulation that specifically regulates such limitations to the regulation on the implementation of sanctions.

SEVENTH

To the Governors and Regents/Mayors in regions that do not include the enforcement of limitations regulation as referred to in the FIRST Dictum, to continue to strengthen and improve socialization and law enforcement against violations of the Covid-19 health protocols.

EIGHT

: To all Governors and Regents/Mayors:

- a. to re-optimize the provincial level Covid-19 task force post, regent/city to village levels. Especially for village regions, in handling and controlling the Covid-19 pandemic, the Village Revenue and Expenditure Budget (*Anggaran Pendapatan* dan Belanja Desa or APBDesa) can be used in an accountable, transparent, and responsible manner; and
- b. seeks to prevent and avoid crowds either by persuasive means to all parties or through law enforcement by involving security forces (Civil Service Police Unit, National Police of the Republic of Indonesia and involving the Indonesian National Army).

NINTH

This Ministerial Instruction shall come into force on the date of its issuance.
