DECREE NUMBER 6 OF 2021 REGARDING

HOTEL CRITERIA AND RT-PCR OBLIGATIONS FOR INDONESIAN CITIZENS WHO TRAVEL INTERNATIONALLY

HEAD OF THE COVID-19 HANDLING TASK FORCE

Considering

- : a. whereas to implement the provisions of the Addendum of Circular Letter of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force Number 3 of 2020 and Circular Letter of the Head of COVID-19 Handling Task Force Number 4 of 2020, for Indonesian Citizens who conducts international travels during the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) Pandemic are obligated to conduct quarantine in the hotel for a period of 5 (five) days and conduct RT-PCR;
 - whereas for efficiency and effectivity on the implementation of hotel quarantine as referred to in letter a, it is necessary to stipulate the hotel criteria for Indonesian Citizens of International Travels and RT-PCR test obligation in which its funding is sourced from Ready to Use Fund (*Dana Siap Pakai*);
 - whereas based on the considerations as referred to in letter a
 and letter b, it is necessary to stipulate the Decree of the Head
 of the COVID-19 Handling Task Force regarding hotel criteria
 and RT-PCR test obligation for Indonesian Citizens Travelling
 Internationally;

HAS DECIDED:

To Stipulate

: DECREE OF THE HEAD OF THE COVID-19 HANDLING TASK FORCE REGARDING HOTEL CRITERIA AND RT-PCR TEST OBLIGATIONS FOR INDONESIAN CITIZENS WHO TRAVEL INTERNATIONALLY.

FIRST

: To implement the hotel criteria used as the place of quarantine for Indonesian Citizens Who Travel Internationally shall be hotels with maximum 3 (three) stars of which services consist of lodging, transportation, meal, laundry, and security as well as health.

SECOND

: RT-PCR test obligation as referred to in the FIRST dictum shall be conducted 2 (two) times which shall be during the arrival and exit from the hotel quarantine.

THIRD

: Funding of quarantine Hotels and RT-PCR tests shall be sourced from the Ready to Use Fund (*Dana Siap Pakai* or DSP) of the National Body of Disaster Management and must only be allocated for Indonesian Citizens Who Travels Internationally with the status of Indonesian Migrant Workers (*Pekerja Migran Indonesia* or PMI), Indonesian Work Force (*Tenaga Kerja Indonesia* or TKI), Students/ University Students and Indonesian Citizens who are economically unable, declared by the relevant statement letter with sufficient stamp.

FOURTH

: Mechanism of the quarantine hotel payment shall be conducted by the Commitment Formation Official (*Pejabat Pembuat Komitmen* or PPK) who is appointed by the Budget User Authority (*Kuasa Pengguna Anggaran*, KPA) BNPN in accordance with the laws and regulations and after passing the verification/review process by the BPKP.

FIFTH

: This Decree shall come into force on January 6, 2021 provided that if an error is contained in the future, correction will be conducted accordingly.
